NYC Department of City Planning announces the PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD and PUBLIC HEARING for the Proposed 2012 Consolidated Plan. The thirty-day PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD will begin on OCTOBER 11, 2011, and will end NOVEMBER 9, 2011.

A PUBLIC HEARING will be held on THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2011, beginning at 2:30 P.M. at 22 Reade Street, Spector Hall, New York, N.Y. 10007. The Public Hearing will be followed by a question and answer session with City agency representatives in attendance.

The 2012 Proposed Consolidated Plan contains the City's annual application for four U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Planning and Development programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).

Proposed Funding allocations for 2012 are as follows: CDBG \$235.438 million; HOME \$110.538 million; ESG \$7.908 million; HOPWA \$55.968 million, totaling \$409.852 million.

The 2012 Proposed Consolidated Plan consists of three volumes: Volume 1. Contains an Executive Summary that provides an overview of the proposed use of entitlement grant dollars during the calendar year and the public's comments to the proposal and the Action Plan: One-Year Use of Funds; Volume 2. Contains the City's Supportive Housing Continuum of Care for the Homeless and Other Non-Homeless Special Needs Populations, and Other Actions, which are the statutory requirements of the Cranston-Gonzalez Housing Act's Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy; and Volume 3. Summary of Citizens' Comments, and Appendices.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED in the Environmental Control Board by Section 1049-(a) of the New York City Charter, and in accordance with Section 1043(b) of the Charter, that the Environmental Control Board hereby promulgates the following rule. The rule was published in The City Record on July 14, 2011 and a Public Hearing was held on August 16, 2011.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Final Rule

The Environmental Control Board (ECB) held a Public Hearing on August 16, 2011 regarding amendments to its Public Safety Graffiti Penalty Schedule. This schedule is found in §3-119 of Subchapter G of Chapter 3 of Title 48 of the Rules of the City of New York. This schedule includes a charge for the use or discharge of fireworks without a permit. Neither written comments nor oral testimony were presented at the August 16, 2011 Public Hearing.

The Fire code was changed in 2008 and A. C. 27-4047(a) is no longer valid. The correct section of law is 29-109.2.4. To better advise the public of the penalty for this charge, ECB has amended the penalty schedule to show the correct section of the law.

The amount of the penalty, \$750, was not changed.

Section 1. The Public Safety Graffiti Penalty Schedule found in §3-119 of Subchapter G of Chapter 3 of Title 48 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to revise the entry in that penalty schedule for § 27-4047(a), "Use or discharge of fireworks without a permit," to read as follows:

Summary of Determinations and Certifications of Amount of Bonds to be issued by The City of New York

Pursuant to the New York Local Finance Law (the "Law") and Sections 8 and 219 of the New York City Charter, the Mayor of the City of New York (the "City"), acting as the Finance Board of the City, has determined in Capital Proceed Directive Bond Resolutions 120000005, 120000004, 120000003, 110000037, 110000036, 110000035, 110000034, 110000033, 110000032, 110000031, 110000030, 110000029, 110000028 and 110000027 OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK

110000033, 110000032, 110000031, 110000030, 110000029, 110000028 and 110000027 (the "Resolutions") that obligations shall be issued to finance the specific objects or purposes identified as budget codes ("Budget Codes") in the Resolutions, to the extent and in the amounts set forth in Capital Budget Code modifications ("BCMs") attached to such Resolutions, and has certified by the Resolutions to the Comptroller of the City the amounts of obligations to be issued for financing the Budget Codes. Said amounts have been duly appropriated for the Budget Codes in appropriations for capital projects to which the Budget Codes relate.

The Resolutions request that the Comptroller determine the nature and terms of the obligations thereby authorized and that the Comptroller arrange for the issuance of such obligations.

The period of probable usefulness for each Budget Code is set forth in the description of such Budget Code in the financial management system reports of the City and is incorporated in the Resolutions by reference. The estimated maximum cost of each Budget Code is its proportionate share of the estimated maximum cost of the capital project of which such Budget Code is a part. The estimated maximum costs of each such project and the plan for financing the total costs of all of the Budget Codes comprising such project, are contained in the most recent Capital Budget in which the funds for such capital project were appropriated. Solicitation notices for most procurements valued at or above \$100,000 for information technology and for construction and construction related services, above \$50,000 for other services, and above \$25,000 for other goods are published for at least one day. Other types of procurements, such as sole source, require notice in The City Record for five consecutive days. Unless otherwise specified, the agencies and offices listed are open for business Monday through Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., except on legal holidays.

NOTICE TO ALL NEW YORK CITY CONTRACTORS

The New York State Constitution ensures that all laborers, workers or mechanics employed by a contractor or subcontractor doing public work are to be paid the same wage rate that prevails in the trade where the public work is being done. Additionally, New York State Labor Law §§ 220 and 230 provide that a contractor or subcontractor doing public work in construction or building service must pay its employees no less than the prevailing wage. Section 6-109 (the Living Wage Law) of the New York City Administrative Code also provides for a "living wage", as well as prevailing wage, to be paid to workers employed by City contractors in certain occupations. The Comptroller of the City of New York is mandated to enforce prevailing wage. Contact the NYC Comptroller's Office at www.comptroller.nyc.gov, and click on Prevailing Wage Schedules to view rates.

Any denial or revocation of pre-qualified status can be appealed to the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings (OATH). Section 3-10 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules describes the criteria for the general use of pre-qualified lists. The Procurement Policy Board Rules generally require that the City pay its bills within 30 days after the receipt of a proper invoice. The City pays interest on all late invoices. However, there are certain types of payments that are not eligible for interest; these are listed in Section 4-06 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules. The Comptroller and OMB determine the interest rate on late payments twice a year: in January and in July.

HOW TO READ CR PROCUREMENT NOTICES

Procurement notices in the CR are arranged by alphabetically listed Agencies, and within Agency, by Division if any. The notices for each Agency (or Division) are further divided into three subsections: Solicitations, Awards; and Lists & Miscellaneous notices. Each of these subsections separately lists notices pertaining to Goods, Services, or Construction.

Notices of Public Hearings on Contract Awards appear at the end of the Procurement Section.

At the end of each Agency (or Division) listing is a paragraph giving the specific address to contact to secure, examine and/or to submit bid or proposal documents, forms, plans, specifications, and other information, as well as where bids will be publicly opened and read. This address should be used for the purpose specified unless a different one is given in the individual notice. In that event, the directions in the individual notice should be followed.
