EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15

October 28, 1994

TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS OF CERTAIN CLINICAL PROGRAMS OF THE  
NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE  
NEW YORK CITY HEALTH AND HOSPITALS CORPORATION, CONSISTENT  
WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the transfer of five (5) New York City Department of Health clinical programs encompassing Child Health, Dental Health, Correctional Health, Communicare and Homeless Health (hereinafter the "Programs") to the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation would result in more effective delivery of primary medical care services to the citizens of the City of New York; and

WHEREAS, the City of New York and the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation recognize that the transfer of the Programs, subject to appropriate terms and conditions, would serve the best interests of the residents of the City of New York; and

WHEREAS, the City of New York and the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation intend to enter into agreements containing the terms and conditions for the provision of services by the Programs; and

WHEREAS, such agreements will provide for the transfer of the programs to take place by November 27, 1994, or as soon as possible thereafter;


NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it hereby is ordered:

Section 1. Effective November 27, 1994, or as soon as possible thereafter as a transfer of said Programs may be effectuated pursuant to the terms and conditions of duly executed agreements between the City of New York and the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation, the New York City Health

Department shall transfer to the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation the functions of the "Programs" and the employees thereof consistent with such terms and conditions.

Section 2. The City Personnel Director and Health Commissioner shall take all steps necessary, consistent with applicable law, to implement Section 1 of this Order, including ensuring the transfer from the New York City Department of Health to the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation of employees substantially engaged in the performance of the functions of the Programs.

Section 3. This Order shall take effect immediately.
