



Average Daily Inmate Population and Operating Expenditures




Expenditures exclude costs of fringe benefits, correctional health pensions, and judgements and claims.


Agency-wide Overtime (OT) Expense Relative to Inmate Population



Fight/Assault Infractions





Inmate Assaults on Staff






Department of Correction Uniformed Employee to Inmate Ratio
