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




I. Population Change: DOC Population by Custody Status

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 7/3/2021 - 7/9/2021










Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 July 3 – July 9, 2021


Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 March 17, 2020 – July 9, 2021








III. Housing: People in Likely Exposed but Asymptomatic Housing¹




III. Housing: Percentage of People in Custody in Housing Areas with a COVID-19 Housing Designation¹








