## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 290**

## EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING WAIVER OF FEES RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF STORM DAMAGED BUSINESSES

April 1, 2013

WHEREAS, Executive Order 282, issued March 27, 2013, contains a proclamation extending a state of emergency in the City of New York, and such proclamation remains in effect for a period not to exceed thirty days or until rescinded, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, the Governor issued a declaration of emergency for all counties in the State of New York, including the City of New York, and such declaration remains in effect for a period not to exceed six months or until rescinded, whichever occurs first;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 246, issued February 20, 2013, contains an emergency order regarding waiver of fees related to the operation of storm damaged businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

- § 1. The emergency order regarding waiver of certain fees related to the operation of storm damaged businesses forth in Executive Order 246 is hereby extended for five days.
- § 2. This Order shall take effect immediately. It shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.
