


I. Population Change: DOC Population by Custody Status


Total DOC Population by Custody Status November 20, 2021 – November 26, 2021


I. Population Change: City Sentenced Population by Custody Status








Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 November 20 – November 26, 2021

Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody March 17, 2020 – November 26, 2021














