

Collection Notice

The items you set out for collection were not collected because they do not meet NYC Department of Sanitation guidelines as described below:

<u> </u>	Large items that cannot fit in a bag or bin (e.g., furniture, a mattress, etc.) must be set out the night before your trash-only collection day. There is not enough room for large items in our dual-bin trucks used on recycling and composting days. Visit nyc.gov/CollectionDay to find your schedule.
	Hazardous waste such as rechargeable batteries, some electronics, household chemicals and more must be taken to a Special Waste Site or SAFE event. These items can EXPLODE in our trucks and put Sanitation Workers and the public in danger! Visit nyc.gov/SafeDisposal for information and to find a location.
<u> </u>	Refrigerators, air conditioners, water coolers, and dehumidifiers or other appliances containing non-flammable Chlorofluorocarbon gas (CFC—also known as Freon) require an appointment to remove the CFC—a hazardous chemical that must be disposed of separately. Call 311 or visit nyc.gov/cfc to schedule an appointment.
	Broken glass and sharp items must be in a labeled, secure container to avoid injury during collection.
<u> </u>	Mattresses must be in sealed bags to prevent the spread of bed bugs.
