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










# Number and Percent of Patients Under Observation or with Confirmed COVID-19 June 6 - June 12, 2020

#### II. CHS and DOC Updates to BOC: Patients Currently Under Observation by CHS





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#### II. CHS and DOC Updates to BOC: Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19







#### Number of People In Likely Exposed but Asymptomatic Housing, March 16 - June 12, 2020




#### Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 - June 12th, 2020


