Executive Order No. 95

NEW YORK CITY ENERGY  
AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS OFFICE

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

**Section 1. Office Established.** The New York City Energy and Telecommunications Office (the "Office") is hereby established in the Office of the Mayor. The Office shall be headed by a Director, who shall also serve as the Director of the New York City Public Utility Service ("NYCPUS"). The Director shall report to the Deputy Mayor for Finance and Economic Development.

**Section 2. Responsibilities.** The Office shall (a) have overall responsibility for the development and coordination of energy policy and telecommunications policy for the City, and (b) exercise all of the functions, powers and duties of the public utility service established by Chapter 73 of the New York City Administrative Code.

**Section 3. Staff and Expenses.** The Office shall have such staff and incur such expenses necessary for it to perform its responsibilities and effectuate its purposes.

**Section 4. Annual Report.** The Office shall report annually to the Mayor on its activities and shall prepare such other reports as the Mayor shall request.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Order shall take effect immediately and supersedes Executive Order No. 67, dated January 24, 1983, which is hereby revoked.
