



The Mayor's Office of Environmental Coordination (MOEC) is acting as the CEQR Lead Agency for the environmental review. The Applicant is seeking a series of land use actions including a zoning map amendment and City Map amendments (the "Proposed Actions") from the City Planning Commission. The Development Site is approximately 78 acres of land bounded by Seaver Way to the east, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) Corona Yard to the south, Grand Central Parkway to the west, and Northern Boulevard to the north. The Project Area extends slightly beyond the Development Site. These additional areas include roadways and landscaped areas adjacent to the Grand Central Parkway and the Whitestone Expressway. The Project Area is subject to the Proposed Actions and is located in the Flushing Meadows Corona Park area of Queens Joint Interest Area 81. The Proposed Actions, along with other discretionary approvals, would facilitate the development of 3.7 million square feet of new construction, with destination entertainment that includes a gaming facility, music hall, a hotel with up to 2,300 rooms, convention and meeting space, restaurant and retail space, and office and community facility space (The Proposed Project). The Proposed Project would also include at least 20 acres of public park space, amenity space for the hotel, and structured parking facilities to accommodate up to 13,750 spaces. What authorizes DOB to make this rule? Sections 643 and 1043(a) of the City Charter and Chapter 4 of Title 28 of the City Administrative Code authorize DOB to make this proposed rule. This proposed rule was included in DOB’s regulatory agenda for this Fiscal Year.

Where can I find DOB’s rules? DOB’s rules are in Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What rules govern the rulemaking process? DOB must meet the requirements of Section 1043 of the City Charter when creating or changing rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of Section 1043(b) of the City Charter.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rule

Since the enactment of Local Law 196 of 2017, which mandated construction site safety training, the course provider program has expanded and the costs of administering the program, including contract costs and staffing needs, have increased. In 2017 there were approximately 40 course providers.

Today there are over 150, significantly increasing the Department’s workload in terms of approving the providers, requiring the imposition of registration fees. Under section 1 of this proposed rule, Rule 101-03 is amended to include a new initial registration fee of \$3,250 and a new renewal registration fee of \$3,185.

Under section 2, Rule 105-03 is amended to improve compliance by course providers. Specifically, the rule:

- Creates a registration for course providers as of July 1, 2025 and subjects them to the suspension and revocation provisions of Section 28-401.19 of the Administrative Code.
- States that the Department may refuse to renew a registration pursuant to Section 28-401.19 of the Administrative Code.

- Provides that course provider approvals issued prior to July 1, 2025 will continue to be valid and that course providers may continue to offer Department-approved courses after July 1, 2025, provided they submit an application to register by June 30, 2025.
- Adds language about investigations and audits.
- Clarifies recording-keeping requirements.
- Provides guidance on how providers can advertise.
- Provides guidance on how to conduct non-traditional course/class formats.
- Removes sections that are no longer relevant because the deadlines have passed or the described processes are no longer followed.
- Creates a requirement for providers to upload data to DOB's online platform.
- Adds a requirement that a course provider upload certificates of completion prior to withdrawing from the course provider program.

In addition, two sections of Chapter 3300 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York - sections 3301-03, regarding construction worker safety information signs, and 3321-01, regarding construction site safety training - are repealed, as their provisions are currently in effect and covered by Section 3321 of the Building Code.

The Department of Buildings' authority for this proposed rule is found in sections 643 and 1043 of the New York City Charter.

Section 1. Section 101-03 of subchapter A of chapter 100 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended by adding the following entry at the end of the table set forth in that section:

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§2. Section 105-03 of subchapter E of chapter 100 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§105-03 Course Provider Registration and Department-Approved Courses.

(a) [Scope. This section outlines the requirements for Department-approved courses required by the Administrative Code and Department rules for training, license qualification and licensee continuing education. Unless otherwise authorized under the Administrative Code or Department rules, only Department-approved courses may be offered to fulfill Department course requirements]

Registration. Beginning on July 1, 2025, no course provider may offer Department-approved courses unless such course provider is registered with the Department in accordance with this section. Such registration is valid for one year from the date of registration.

- (1) Current course providers may continue to offer courses until July 1, 2025, provided they apply for registration between the effective date of this section and July 1, 2025, in accordance with the provisions of subdivision (b) of this section. Providers who fail to apply must complete any course currently being offered and upload the certificates as provided in this section but may not offer any additional courses.
- (2) Once the department approves the application, the provider will be considered registered as of that date.
- (3) In the event the department denies the application, the applicant may reapply or may challenge the determination in accordance with the provisions of Section 28-401.21 of the Administrative Code. The provider may continue to operate until the reapplication or challenge is decided.

(b) Course Provider Application and Renewal Process.

- (1) The course provider applicant must submit:
 - (i) an application form provided by the Department;
 - (ii) proof that the applicant has met the requirements of paragraph (2) of subdivision [(e)](f) of this section; [and]
 - (iii) a statement attesting that the applicant will ensure that all instructors comply with the requirements of subdivision [(d)](e) of this section and, if applicable, subdivision [(g)](h) of this section. Course providers who are already approved as of the effective date of this subparagraph must comply with its provisions by January 1, 2020.; and
 - (iv) a fee as set forth in section 101-03 of these rules.

- (2) [A listing of the providers of the approved courses will be available through the Department's website.] Incomplete [or inaccurate] applications will be rejected.
- (3) [Incomplete or inaccurate applications will be returned to the applicant and may be resubmitted once complete or corrected] Applications for renewal must be accompanied by the renewal fee and such additional information as the commissioner may require. Such applications must be made at least 30 days but not more than 60 days prior to the expiration of the applicant's registration.

(c) Investigation of applicant. The Department or its designee will conduct an investigation of each applicant to determine its qualification to become a course provider. The burden of proving that an applicant meets the required qualifications is on the applicant. An applicant's failure to meet the requirements specified by the Administrative Code or by the Department's rules, and/or an applicant's refusal to cooperate with an investigation will result in denial of the application.

(d) Approved Courses. Unless otherwise authorized under the Administrative Code or Department rules, only Department-approved courses may be offered to fulfill Department course requirements. A listing of registered providers of approved courses is available on the Department's website. The course provider must ensure compliance with the provisions of this subdivision [(c)].

- (1) Course Requirements.
 - (i) All courses must comply with the Department's course curricula published on its website, which lists the relevant citations for statutory or other requirements listed in this paragraph.
 - (ii) No more than four (4) hours of any curriculum may consist of course materials or credits to be applied to multiple license types.

Exception: Subparagraph (ii) does not apply to course curricula for Master and Special Electrician, Master Plumber and Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractor.

- (iii) All curricula must include the following information as applicable to the relevant construction trade:
 - (A) Business practices;
 - (B) Relevant Building Code provisions, rules, and policy and procedure notices enacted or promulgated by the Department;
 - (C) Administrative Code provisions, rules and policy and procedure notices enacted or promulgated by any other City agency;
 - (D) Overview of Occupational Safety and Health Standards ("OSHS") for the Construction Industry;
 - (E) Relevant Department of Buildings filing and inspection requirements;
 - (F) Safety/hazardous materials;
 - (G) New technology;
 - (H) Corruption prevention standards; and
 - (I) Other subjects identified by the Commissioner.

(iv) All courses must reflect any changes in the Department's published course curricula or any applicable laws, rules and regulations within ninety (90) days.

(2) Notification of Approved Courses. [(i)]The course provider must have [a]its own website and must publish course schedules on its website, including dates, times, locations, the cost of the training and whether such cost includes the cost of issuing the identification card or site safety training card required by this section, the cost of such card if it is not included in the training cost, and must [otherwise make] submit all course schedules [available in writing] to the Department [upon request]. The course provider must also notify the Department of any changes to a scheduled course at least three (3) business days prior to it being offered. All information on the course provider's website, including the location of courses and the courses taught, must be current.

[(ii) The course provider must notify the Department of any changes to the course within fourteen (14) days of such change.]

(3) Course Review. At the end of each course, the instructor(s) must conduct a review of the materials taught. The Department may require that a hands-on or written performance evaluation be given to attendees.

(4) Course Facilities. The course facilities must:

- (i) Have sufficient room to accommodate all expected attendees and the equipment needed to perform hands-on exercises where required as part of the course;
- (ii) Make provisions for the presentation of training material in all media types (e.g., computer, projectors, video/ DVD players); and
- (iii) Comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations relating to occupancy, zoning, egress, fire detection, fire suppression, light, ventilation, cleanliness, sanitary facilities, emergency notification and evacuation procedures.

(5) Attendance Record. The course provider must have in place fraud-resistant procedures for confirming the identity and attendance of individuals taking any course(s), including logs reflecting those in attendance at different times during the course, and be able to produce the logs and any other documentation demonstrating that an attendee attended the course(s). The logs must include:

- (i) The student's full name (printed);
- (ii) The student's signature;
- (iii) The name of the course;
- (iv) The name of instructor(s);
- (v) The time the course began;
- (vi) The time the course ended;
- (vii) The time of a break (if any), including when the break began and when the break ended;
- (viii) The address where the class/course or course was conducted; and
- (ix) The format in which the class was conducted: in-person, virtual, webinar, hybrid online/in-person training (for hands-on training courses).

(6) Course Completion.

(i) [For training courses, the course provider must issue a wallet-size identification card to attendees upon course completion. Such card must contain the following information:

- (A) The name of the person to whom it was issued;
- (B) A photograph of the person to whom it was issued;
- (C) The name and address of the issuing organization;
- (D) The date of issuance;
- (E) An indication of the type of training and the number of credit hours completed; and
- (F) The signature of the course provider.

(ii) For qualification and continuing education courses, the course provider must issue a certificate of completion to the attendees upon course completion. The course provider must also upload a photograph of the person and a digital copy of the certificate of completion to the Department of Buildings' platform NYC DOB Training Connect, which is only accessible to registered course providers. The course provider must upload the certificate within 60 days of course completion. Such certificate must contain the following information:

- (A) The name of the course;
- (B) The name of the person to whom it was issued;
- [(B)] (C) The name and address of the issuing organization;
- (D) The certificate number;
- [(C)](E) The date of issuance and expiration (if any);
- [(D)](F) An indication of the type of course and the number of credit hours completed; [and]
- [(E)](G) The name and signature of the course provider;
- (H) The name of the instructor; and
- (I) The course provider ID number.

[(iii)] (ii) For training courses, the course provider must issue an identification card to attendees upon course completion. Such card must be issued using the Department of Buildings' platform NYC DOB Training Connect, which is only accessible to registered course providers and can found at <https://dob-trainingconnect.cityofnewyork.us/>.

[(iv)] (iii) The course provider must maintain a record of all the information required on the identification cards and the certificates of completion for a minimum period of seven (7) years from the date of completion. The course provider must make these records available to the Department upon request.

(7) Department Observation and Evaluation. The Department may observe any Department-approved course without prior notification to the course provider or instructor. The Department may evaluate courses taught by course providers through audit or other means at such intervals as it deems necessary and may require additional information as it deems necessary.

(8) Audits. The Department may periodically audit the course provider to ensure compliance with this section and any rules or other Department requirements related to such training.

(9) Cooperation. The course provider must cooperate with investigations related to the course provider's compliance with the requirements of this rule or other applicable law.

[(d)](e) **Course Instructor(s).** Course providers must require that course instructor(s) demonstrate that they are credentialed or trained in instructional methods and learning processes. Course providers must also require that the instructor(s) successfully demonstrate their ability to solve or resolve problems relating to the subject matter by possession of a recognized degree, certificate, licensure or professional standing, or by extensive knowledge, training, and experience, in the subject matter being taught. To the extent that the course instructor(s) holds, or has held, a trade license issued by the Department, such license must be in good standing and not be surrendered to, suspended by or revoked by the Department.

- (1) For Supported Scaffold, Suspended Scaffold and Mast-Climber training courses, the instructor(s) must also be authorized by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") as a trainer(s) for its Construction and Outreach Program.
- (2) For Hoisting Machine Operator courses, the instructor(s) must also hold a valid New York City Hoisting Machine Operator's license or hold a national certification for crane operation.
- (3) For Master and Special Electrician courses, the instructor(s) must demonstrate credentials or training in instructional methods and learning processes through licensure or certification, including but not limited to, certification as an electrical course provider in jurisdictions following the National Electrical Code/NFPA 70.
- (4) The course instructor(s) must comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules and regulations.
- (5) The course instructor(s) must be in compliance with the Department's Industry Code of Conduct.

[(e)](f) **Course Provider Requirements.**

- (1) The course provider must be a sole proprietorship, a partnership or a corporation that provides training, an educational institution, a governmental agency or authority, a trade union, or a trade association, provided that a governmental agency or authority need not comply with paragraph (2) of this subdivision.
- (2) The course provider must provide proof that it is:
 - (i) approved by or licensed as an educational institution by the New York State Department of Education;
 - (ii) registered as a New York State Department of Labor vocational, trade or apprenticeship program;
 - (iii) accredited by an accrediting organization recognized by the United States Department of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation; or
 - (iv) certified by an organization accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) as a Standards Developing Organization with published standards for continuing education and training.
 For alternative Mast-Climbing work platform training course provider requirements to those listed in paragraph (2) of subdivision [(e)](f), herein, see section 3314-01(m).
- (3) Course providers must continuously maintain the qualifications required by paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subdivision and by subdivision [(h)](i), if applicable, and must provide a copy of such approval, license, accreditation or certification to the Department upon request. The course provider must immediately notify the Department of any lapse or

expiration of its approval, license, accreditation or certification, including any qualification required by subdivision [(h)](i).

(4) The course provider must comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules and regulations.

(5) The course provider must notify the Department of any changes to the course provider's name within fourteen (14) days of such change.

(6) Course providers must ensure that all their instructors comply with all applicable provisions of this section.

(7) Course providers must be in compliance with the Department's Industry Code of Conduct and Course Provider Program Handbook.

(8) Course providers must notify the Department within thirty (30) days if the course provider makes changes to its business name, its website, or the owner/director of the business by submitting a new application for provider approval with supporting documentation. The provider may continue to offer courses under its current name pending approval of the new application.

(9) Course providers must collect, process and retain student data records as set forth herein. Course providers must implement privacy and data security practices to guard against the unauthorized access, fraud, theft, and other misuse of such information. Course providers may not use the data collected pursuant to this rule for any other purpose, including but not limited for advertisements, without the student's consent. Course providers must comply with all applicable City, State, and federal laws relating to personally identifying information and to privacy, including but not limited to those included in the New York State General Business Law.

[(f)](g) Department as course provider. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Department may act as a provider, or the sole provider, of any course offered to fulfill a Department course requirement. A listing of available Department courses will be posted on the Department's website.

[(g)](h) Site Safety Training (SST) Course Instructors. For the purposes of providing training in accordance with section 3321.1 of the Building Code and this section 105-03, a site safety training (SST) provider, as defined in item 1 of the definition of "Site Safety Training (SST) Provider" in section [3302.1]202 of the Building Code, means a course instructor as used in this section 105-03. In addition to the foregoing requirements for course instructors, an SST course instructor must meet one of the following requirements:

(1) has successfully completed all applicable OSHA or Department requirements for conducting OSHA 10-hour classes and OSHA 30-hour classes and is authorized to conduct such classes, except that such course instructor is not required to possess a degree, certificate, licensure or demonstrate any professional standing as required by subdivision [(d)](e), beyond what is required in this paragraph;

(2) is providing training through a 100-hour training program; or

(3) is approved by the Department to conduct a 40-hour Site Safety Manager training course in accordance with article 402 of Chapter 4 of the Administrative Code.

[(h)](i) Site Safety Training (SST) Course Providers. A site safety training (SST) provider as defined in item 2 of the definition of "Site Safety Training (SST) Provider" in section [3302.1]202 of the Building Code must comply with the requirements for course providers in this section 105-03 as well as with the applicable requirements of this subdivision [(h)].

(1) If a not-for-profit organization or a governmental agency or authority is an SST provider, it must meet the standards set forth by the Department instead of the requirement in paragraph (2) of subdivision [(e)](f).

(2) [Not later than March 1, 2021, an] An SST provider must certify to the Department that it has a language access plan that complies with requirements established by another City agency or office designated by the Mayor, as required by item 2.1 of the definition of SST provider in section 202 of the Building Code.

(3) Training may be conducted in person or in an actively proctored online format and must comply with the following:

(i) If conducted in person in a classroom setting, the SST provider must confirm the identification of the individual taking such training and must ensure that the site of such training is actively observed for the duration of the training.

(ii) If the online training is not performed in person, the SST provider must confirm the identification of the individual prior to providing secure access to the online training. The individual must attest that he/she is the individual who received the online access and will complete the training without assistance. The online program must have secure access and monitor participation during the course of training to ensure that the individual receiving the training is present for the entirety of the training.

(4) Upon completion of the SST course, the SST provider [or, if applicable, a third party,] must issue an SST card in accordance with subdivision [(i)](j) of this section. [The provisions of paragraph (6) of subdivision (c) of this section do not apply to SST courses.]

(5) If the SST provider is not the provider of the OSHA course that is required for an SST card, as defined in section [3302.1]202 of the Building Code, the SST provider must ensure that the OSHA course was conducted either in person or, if online, was actively proctored before issuing an SST card as provided in subdivision [(i)](j) of this section.

(6) The SST provider [or, if applicable, a third party,] must accept documentation, including identification cards or certificates of completion, from [a Department-approved] registered course providers. Course providers must accept SST course equivalent, as set out on the Department's website, and must apply such course hours to satisfy the training requirements of this section and section BC 3321 of the Building Code.

[(7) Beginning October 1, 2019, and on January 1, April 1 and October 1 of each year thereafter, the course provider must report the number of SST, temporary SST, limited SST and supervisory SST cards issued each quarter in a format required by the Department.]

[(i)](j) SST cards to be issued upon course completion. [The Department may require SST course completion cards to be issued by a third party. Until such time as a third party process is instituted, an] An SST provider must, upon completion of the SST course, issue a temporary SST card, [limited SST card,] SST card, or SST supervisor card, in accordance with subdivision [(h)](i), this subdivision and section [3302.1]202 of the Building Code. Such card must be issued using the Department of Buildings' platform NYC DOB Training Connect, which is only accessible to registered course providers.

(1) Such card must be wallet-sized and must conform to the guidelines posted on the Department's website.

(2) Any SST card issued prior to the effective date of this rule must conform to the guidelines posted on the Department's website. The course provider who issued such SST card must replace non-conforming cards by April 1, 2020 with cards that comply.]

[(j)](k) Record-keeping and verification of SST Cards.

(1) The SST course provider [or, if applicable, a third party,] must maintain a record of all temporary SST cards, [limited SST cards,] SST cards, or SST supervisor cards issued for a minimum of seven years. The SST course provider [or, if applicable, a third party,] must make these records available to the Department or its designee upon request.

(2) The SST course provider or, if applicable, a third party, must maintain a secure online verification system containing an up-to-date list of the name of the card holder, the unique identification card number, and the issuance and expiration date of the card. Such verification must be available to the City, including the Department or its designee, and contractors, to enable readily accessible confirmation of the names of SST card holders who have completed the SST training through the particular course provider.]

(l) Advertising. Course providers may only advertise courses/classes that they are authorized by the Department to deliver.

(m) Third Parties. The course provider may not delegate or outsource any of its duties, responsibilities or functions to any third party that is not registered with the Department. The course provider must maintain full accountability for its operations and ensure that all services provided are conducted in compliance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules and regulations.

(n) Nontraditional Format Courses/Classes.

(1) The course provider may conduct training in a non-traditional format. A non-traditional format is any format other than the traditional in-person classroom format. Non-traditional formats may include virtual classrooms, webinars, on-demand training, or hybrid virtual classroom/in-person training for hands-on courses.

(2) Training conducted in a non-traditional format must comply with the following:

- (i) The non-traditional format course must be approved by the Department.
- (ii) The provider must confirm the identification of the individual taking such training by adhering to the actively proctored online format requirements.
- (iii) The provider must ensure that participants have their web-cameras activated and are on-camera for the duration of classes conducted virtually.
- (iv) For courses that include hands-on training, providers may deliver the hands-on portion of the training in-person and the remaining portion through either a live virtual classroom or live webinar.
- (v) The provider must notify the Department when the hands-on portion of the course/class is scheduled.
- (vi) All students must be scheduled at the same time to receive the hands-on training.

(o) Denial of Registration Renewal. The department may, following notice and an opportunity to be heard, refuse to renew a registration on any grounds on the basis of which it could deny, suspend or revoke such registration pursuant to Section 28-401.19 of the Administrative Code.

[(k)](p) Suspension and Revocation of [Approval] Registration.

(1) [Following notice and an opportunity to be heard, the] The Department may, in accordance with the provisions of Section 28-401.19.1 of the Administrative Code, take corrective action, including probation, suspension, or revocation of a course provider's [authority to conduct classes and to distribute course completion cards] registration, for failure to comply with the requirements of this section or with the requirements of any applicable law, rule, or regulation. However, when the public safety may be imminently jeopardized, the Commissioner may, pending [an opportunity to be heard and Department determination] a hearing and determination of charges, suspend [approval] registration for a period not exceeding [thirty (30)] fifteen (15) days.

- (2) The basis for the suspension or revocation of a course approval may form the basis for the suspension or revocation of any or all of that course provider's approved courses.
- (3) The Department will post on its website that the approval of a course or course provider registration has been suspended or revoked.

(q) Withdrawal. The course provider must notify the Department and its students at least 30 days prior to its withdrawal from the course provider program. The course provider must be in compliance with the record-keeping provisions of this rule, including uploading certificates of completion into the Department's online platform, Training Connect, before its withdrawal.

§3. Section 3301-03 of Chapter 3300 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York regarding construction worker safety information signs and section 3321-01 of Chapter 3300 regarding construction site safety training are REPEALED.

Notice of Adoption

Notice of Adoption to amend and add Department of Consumer and Worker Protection ("DCWP" or "Department") rules related to process servers in order to clarify requirements and ensure consistency with recent changes to state law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED in the Commissioner of the Department of Consumer and Worker Protection by Sections 1043 and 2203(f) of the New York City Charter and Section 20-406.3 of the New York City Administrative Code, and in accordance with the requirements of such Section 1043, that the Department amends, and adds a new section and certain clarifying language, to chapter 2 of title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York.

This rule was proposed and published on July 22, 2024. A public hearing was held on August 21, 2024 and comments regarding the rule were received.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Rule

DCWP amends and adds rules relating to process servers to clarify requirements and ensure consistency with recent changes to state law.

DCWP amends sections 2-233, 2-234, 2-235, 2-236, and 2-240 of chapter 2 of title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York ("RCNY") to allow process servers to submit affirmations in place of notarized affidavits, in accordance with Rule 2106 of the New York Civil Practice Laws and Rules ("CPLR").

DCWP amends section 2-233(a) of chapter 2 of title 6 of the RCNY making the required fields of information for records of service consistent with the Department's website template.

DCWP amends section 2-233(c) and (e) of chapter 2 of title 6 of the RCNY clarifying that the records stored with the third-party contractor must contain required information in the format provided on the

Department's website and that process servers are required to produce such records in this format.

DCWP amends section 2-233b of chapter 2 of title 6 of the RCNY:

- detailing the records that process servers must retain in electronic format clarifying the format in which these records must be produced to the process servers and DCWP by third party contractors;
- re-emphasizing that, to comply with this provision, these records may not be made before the time of attempted or effected service; and
- creating a rebuttable presumption of non-compliance of the provision requiring "immediate" recordation after attempted or effected service if the electronic records are made more than five minutes after the time of attempted or effected service.

DCWP clarifies the requirements of section 2-235 of chapter 2 of title 6 of the RCNY, and adds a new section 2-235a, setting forth already applicable legal requirements for affidavits and affirmations submitted to court, and for sworn-to or affirmed testimony. See CPLR 306 and Article 210 of the New York Penal Law. Specifically, DCWP adds language to section 2-235 clarifying that when serving a business, process servers must include certain information in affidavits and affirmations of service to ensure the individual served is authorized to receive service.

DCWP amends section 2-240 of chapter 2 of title 6 of the RCNY so that each failure to comply with a document production demand constitutes a separate violation.

The Department received comments about the rule from the public, which resulted in the following changes:

- removing the subdivision concerning the labeling of electronic records in § 2-233b
- reducing the number of fields of information required for electronic records of service in § 2-233b

The effective date of the rule is March 1, 2025.

Sections 1043 and 2203(f) of the New York City Charter and Section 20-406.3 of the New York City Administrative Code authorize the Department of Consumer and Worker Protection to make this rule.

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Section 1. Section 233 of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-233 Records.

(a) *Duty of individual process server to keep records.* Each process server must maintain records of all service made by them in compliance with the provisions of section 89-cc of the New York General Business Law and § 20-406.3 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, as follows:

(1) *Maintenance of records of service.* Process servers must maintain records of all service and attempted service by keeping bound paginated volumes or by storing electronic records with a third party contractor.

(i) *Bound paginated volumes.* Where a process server maintains records in bound paginated volumes, the process server must record each entry separately in chronological order contemporaneous with service or attempted service. The process server must make entries in only one volume at a time, which must contain every attempted and effected service made by the process server, until all of the available space in the volume is filled. A process server who maintains records in bound paginated volumes must also maintain an electronic copy of such volumes by scanning records into an image file that legibly reproduces in all details the original record the process server maintains in bound paginated volumes. Such electronic record must be kept as follows:

(A) the image file must be named with the date of the service or attempted service recorded in the bound paginated volume and the process server's license number, and must be date and time stamped with the date and time that the file was created; and

(B) such scanning must be done within three business days from the last event recorded in the records; and

(C) the process server must save the scanned image file in a manner that:

(I) ensures the authenticity, reliability and integrity of the scanned image file;

(II) permits the efficient retrieval of the scanned image file;

(III) contains a backup support system such that the scanned image file must be capable of being reconstructed if an electronic or computer malfunction or unforeseen incident resulting in the destruction of the system or the information contained therein; and

(D) where the process server stores scanned image files on a portable media device, such portable media device must be labeled with the process server's last name, license number and the date range of the records stored on the device;

(ii) *Electronic records with a third party contractor.* Where a process server maintains electronic records with a third party contractor, the process server must submit recorded entries in chronological order to such contractor within three business days of service or attempted service. The process server must enter a contract with a contractor pursuant to which such contractor must be required to provide services and perform functions consistent with 6 RCNY § 2-233(c), provided, however, the process server may use the services and functions for electronic record storage that a process serving agency has made available to process servers under a contract with a third party contractor.

(2) *Content of records of service.* Each record of service and attempted service must include, at a minimum, the following information:

(i) name of the process server, which will be entered as last name, first name, provided, however, that where a process server keeps records in bound paginated volumes, the name of such process server may be entered on the first page of each bound paginated volume, rather than each record;

(ii) the license number of the process server, which will be specified as a seven-digit number, where the first number must be zero if the process server's license number is less than seven digits, provided, however, that where a process server keeps records in bound paginated volumes, the license number of such process server may be entered on the first page of each bound paginated volume, rather than each record;

(iii) the name and license number of the process serving agency from whom the process served was received, or, if not received from a process serving agency, of such other person or firm from whom the process served was received;

(iv) whether service was effected, as indicated by a Y for yes or N for no;

(v) the title of the action or proceeding or a reasonable abbreviation thereof;

(vi) the name of the intended recipient of the process, which must be entered in two data fields such that the first data field is the last name of the intended recipient, or, if not a natural person, the name of the entity, and the second data field is the first name of the intended recipient if a natural person;

(vii) the name of the individual to whom process was delivered, which must be entered in two data fields such that the first data field is the last name of the individual, and the second data field is the first name of the individual;

(viii) the date that service was attempted or effected, which must be entered as MM/DD/YYYY;

(ix) the time service was attempted or effected, which must be entered as military time;

(x) the address where service was attempted or effected, which must be entered [as] in [three] five different fields; [such that one field will be for the street address and any apartment, suite, or room number, the second field will be for the city or borough, and the third field will be for the ZIP code] the first field will be for the building number; the second field will be for the street name; the third field will be for address details, e.g., apartment, suite, floor or room number; the fourth field will be for the city or borough; and the fifth field will be for the ZIP code;

(xi) the nature of the papers served;

(xii) the court in which the action has been commenced, which must be entered as either Civil Court NYC, Civil Supreme, Criminal, Housing (L/T), or District Court, followed by the county of the court, the judicial department if appellate, or the federal district;

(xiii) the full index number, which must be entered with all information necessary to identify the case, such as XXXXX/XX, unless the case is a Civil Local matter, in which case, it will include the prefix of CV, CC, LT, MI, NC, RE, SC, or TS;

(xiv) if service was effected pursuant to subdivisions (1) through (3) of CPLR § 308, a description of the person served which must consist of seven fields, including sex, color of skin, hair color, approximate age, height, weight, and any other identifying features provided by the process server;

(xv) the type of service delivery, which must be entered as a P for personal delivery service, an S for substituted service, a C for conspicuous service delivery, a CO for corporate service, a PA for partnership service, and a V for VTL service;

(xvi) if service was effected pursuant to subdivision (4) of CPLR § 308 or subdivision (1) of RPAPL § 735, a description of the door and the area adjacent including the color and composition of hallway walls, color and composition of hallway floor or doorstep, and location of premises in relation to stairs, elevator or entranceway;

(xvii) if service is effected pursuant to RPAPL § 735(1) using registered or certified mail, the postal receipt number of registered or certified mail; and

(xviii) if an affidavit or affirmation of service is filed with the court by the process server, the record shall include the date of such filing.

(b) *Duty of licensed process serving agencies to keep records.* Every process serving agency must keep complete and accurate records for each individual process server to whom it assigns or distributes process to be served. Such records must be kept in a searchable manner that permits ready identification of (i) the daily activity of each such individual process server and (ii) any or all process assigned or distributed for service by the name of the person or entity from whom the process serving agency received such papers for service.

(1) *Maintenance of records.* Process serving agencies must maintain electronic records by copying records to an electronic records management system or by submitting records to a third party contractor.

(i) *Electronic records management system.* If the process serving agency elects to store records itself rather than through a third party contractor, it must save the record to an electronic records management system within three business days from the last event recorded in the record. Such electronic records management system must maintain electronic records, including the required records described in 6 RCNY § 2-233(b)(2), in a manner that:

(A) ensures the authenticity, reliability and integrity of the electronic records;

(B) permits the efficient retrieval of electronic records;

(C) contains a backup support system such that the electronic records must be capable of being reconstructed if an electronic or computer malfunction or unforeseen incident results in the destruction of the system or the information contained therein.

(ii) *Third party contractor.* Where a process serving agency maintains its records with a third party contractor, the process serving agency must submit records to such contractor within three business days from the last event recorded in the record. The process serving agency must enter into a contract with such contractor pursuant to which such contractor must be required to provide services and perform functions consistent with 6 RCNY § 2-233(c).

(2) *Required records.* Process serving agencies must maintain, at a minimum, the following records:

(i) An electronic file that legibly reproduces the original record of service or attempted service containing all of the individual process server's records maintained pursuant to 6 RCNY § 2-233(a) of this rule for each day on which the individual process server attempted or effected service of the process assigned or distributed to the individual process server by the process serving agency;

(ii) A copy of every routing sheet, work order or other written instruction given to the individual process server;

(iii) Copies of any notes, memoranda or other writings submitted by the individual process server containing information related to the attempted or effected service of process assigned by the process serving agency;

(iv) A copy of every affidavit of service and affirmation of service signed by the individual process server for service assigned by the process serving agency;

(v) If an affidavit or affirmation of service is filed with the court by the process serving agency, the record must also include the date of such filing.

(c) *Storage of records with a third party contractor.* Where a process server or process serving agency uses a third party contractor to maintain records consistent with 6 RCNY § 2-233(a)(1)(ii) or 6 RCNY

§ 2-233(b)(1)(ii), respectively, such process server or process serving agency must enter a contract with such contractor pursuant to which such contractor must be required to provide services and perform functions that include, but are not limited to:

(1) maintain a daily backup of all submitted data, and ensure all data is available for review upon request of any and all interested parties;

(2) maintain the original electronic record submitted by the process server unaltered for a period of not less than seven years;

(3) prohibit the process server, the process serving agency, or any person to alter the original record;

(4) maintain the records in a manner that will permit retrieval by the DCWP license number of the process server, the DCWP license number of the process serving agency that has distributed the process for service, the name of the plaintiff or petitioner, the name of the defendant or respondent, the docket number (if any), the name of the person to whom process is delivered and a unique file identifier of the process being served;

(5) maintain the records in a manner that will ensure that their integrity is adequate for admissibility in a judicial proceeding under the rules of evidence applicable in the state of New York;

(6) provide a backup support system such that the electronic records must be capable of being reconstructed if an electronic or computer malfunction or unforeseen incident results in the destruction of the system or the information contained therein;

(7) produce upon request by the Department, a copy of the electronic records, or any reasonably described part involved, certified to be true and accurate;

(8) produce to the Department upon request [an MS Excel spreadsheet of] the electronic records containing [the fields and data format] required information set forth in 6 RCNY § 2-233(a)(2) in the format provided by the Department on its website.

(d) *Integrity of records.* Corrections to bound paginated volumes and electronic records with a third party contractor must be made only as follows:

(1) *Bound paginated volumes.* A process server may make corrections in bound paginated volumes only by drawing a straight line through the inaccurate entry and clearly printing the accurate information directly above the inaccurate entry. All other methods of correction, including but not limited to erasing, opaquing, obliterating or redacting, are prohibited.

(2) *Electronic records with a third party contractor.* A process server and process serving agency must ensure that permissions pertaining to electronic records submitted to a third party contractor will be secured so that the data cannot be deleted upon submission to such contractor. No process server or process serving agency may tamper with data or properties of any electronic record kept pursuant to this section after a file is made by modifying, amending, deleting, rearranging or in any other way altering any such data or properties including, but not limited to, using a meta data scrubber or similar device or program. If a typographical error has occurred or if data contained in the process server or process serving agency's record was accidentally omitted from the electronic data entry, the process server or process serving agency must promptly make an amendment to their records of service with the third party contractor. A process server who attempted or effected process may make other corrective amendment, or supplement (such as concerning filing or additional mailing), to the record of service with the third party contractor. Any amendment must be made by creating a new entry in which the original record must be identified by reference in italics within the new entry.

(e) *Retention and production of records.*

(1) Process servers and process serving agencies must retain all records required to be maintained pursuant to this section for a period of seven years from the date of service. Where a process server is employed as a process server by any person, a copy of such records must also be maintained by such person at such person's principal office for the same period;

(2) Upon request by the Department, process servers and process serving agencies must produce a copy of any record they are required to maintain pursuant to this section, or any reasonably described part involved, certified to be true and accurate;

(3) Except where a process server maintains records in bound paginated volumes, process servers must produce, upon request by the Department, the information required to be maintained pursuant to 6 RCNY § 2-233(a)(2) [as an MS Excel spreadsheet] in [a] the format provided by the Department on its website;

(4) Upon request by the Department, process serving agencies must produce the information required to be maintained pursuant to 6 RCNY § 2-233(a)(2) [as an MS Excel spreadsheet] in [a] the format provided by the Department on its website.

Section 2. Section 233b of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-233b Electronic Record of Service / GPS Requirements.

(a) *General Requirements for GPS.* A process server licensed pursuant to this subchapter must comply with the requirement of § 20-410 of the Administrative Code to carry at all times during the commission of [his or her] their licensed activities, and operate at the time process is served or attempted, a device to establish electronically and record the time, date, and location of service or attempted service as follows:

(1) *Equipment.*

(i) The process server must obtain a mobile device, such as a telephone or personal digital assistant, that utilizes the software necessary to make an electronic record of the location where, and the time and date when, the record is made as determined by Global Positioning System ("GPS") technology or Assisted-Global Positioning System ("A-GPS") technology and labels the record with the network date and time maintained by the mobile device, the DCWP license number of the process server, the DCWP license number of the process serving agency that has distributed the process for service, the name of the plaintiff or petitioner, the name of the defendant or respondent, the docket number (if any), the name of the person to whom process is delivered and a unique file identifier of the process being served.

(ii) The mobile device must be equipped with the software necessary to make an electronic record of the location where and time and date when the record is made, as determined by triangulated cell tower signals, if at the time of the effected or attempted service of process a GPS signal is not available.

(iii) The mobile device software must automatically add that location, time and date information to the electronic record as soon as a GPS or cellular signal reaches the device if neither a GPS nor a cellular signal is present at the time the process server causes the electronic record to be made.

(2) *Operation of Equipment.*

(i) On every occasion that a process server attempts or effects service of process, the process server must ensure that the mobile device makes an electronic record of the GPS location, time and date of the attempted or effected service immediately after attempting or effecting service. If no GPS signal is available at the time of attempted or effected service of process, the location, time and date will be determined by triangulated cell tower signals. The process server is not in compliance with this provision if its electronic record was made before the time of attempted or effected service. There shall be a rebuttable presumption that the process server was not in compliance with this provision if its electronic record is made more than five minutes after the time of attempted or effected service.

(ii) Reserved. [Each electronic record must be labeled with:

- (a) the GPS or cellular network date and military time maintained by the mobile device;
- (b) the DCWP license number of the process server;
- (c) the DCWP license number of the process serving agency that distributed the process for service;
- (d) the name of the plaintiff or petitioner;
- (e) the name of the defendant or respondent;
- (f) the docket number, if any;
- (g) the name of the person to whom process is delivered; and
- (h) a unique file identifier of the process being served.]

(iii) Each electronic record must include, at a minimum, the following information:

- (a) a unique file identifier of the process being served;
- (b) the name of the plaintiff or petitioner;
- (c) the name of the defendant or respondent;
- (d) the full index number, entered with all information necessary to identify the case, such as XXXXXX/XX, unless the case is a Civil Local matter, in which case, it will include the prefix of CV, CC, LT, MI, NC, RE, SC, or TS;

- (e) the date that service was effected or attempted according to GPS or cellular signals, entered as MM/DD/YYYY;
- (f) the time that service was effected or attempted according to GPS or cellular signals, entered as military time;
- (g) the location where service was effected or attempted, which must include building number, street name, address details, e.g., apartment, suite, floor or room number, city or borough, ZIP code, which must be five digits, and latitudinal and longitudinal coordinates returned by the GPS device in decimal degree format;
- (h) the name of the person to whom process is delivered;
- (i) the DCWP license number of the process server; and,
- (j) the DCWP license number of the process serving agency that distributed the process for service

(3) *Contract for Services.* The process server must enter into a contract with an independent third party who will provide services and perform functions described in paragraph (4) of this subdivision that enable the process server to meet the data storage and retrieval requirements set forth in such paragraph ("the GPS Contractor"), provided, however, that if the process server performs process serving activities distributed to [him or her] them by a licensed process serving agency, the process server may utilize the device and facilities for the electronic record of service that the process serving agency obtains under a contract with a GPS Contractor.

(4) *Data Storage and Retrieval.* The electronic record must be automatically transmitted electronically from the mobile device to the GPS Contractor as soon as a GPS or cellular signal is available and location, date and time are entered into the electronic record. The GPS Contractor must store the electronic record according to the following terms:

- (i) the original digital file must be maintained by the GPS Contractor unaltered for a period of not less than seven years;
- (ii) neither the process server nor the process serving agency will be permitted to alter the original data, but may obtain copies of the original data file;
- (iii) the GPS Contractor must maintain the records in a manner that will permit retrieval by the DCWP license number of the process server, which will be specified as a seven-digit number, where the first number must be zero if the process server's license number is less than seven digits, the DCWP license number of the process serving agency from whom the process served was received, or, if not received from a process serving agency, the name of such other person or firm from whom the process served was received, the name of the plaintiff or petitioner, the name of the defendant or respondent, the docket number (if any), the name of the person to whom process is delivered and a unique file identifier of the process being served;
- (iv) the GPS Contractor must maintain the records in a manner that will ensure that their integrity is adequate for admissibility in a judicial proceeding under the rules of evidence applicable in the state of New York;
- (v) the GPS Contractor must produce upon request by the process server or the Department, and to any other party according to an appropriate order or subpoena, a copy of the electronic records, or any reasonably described part involved, certified by the GPS Contractor to be true and accurate;
- (vi) the GPS Contractor must provide to the process server or the Department upon request a street map in hard copy format and access to an interactive electronic street map that display the locations where the digital records were recorded with a date and time provided by GPS or cellular date and time;
- (vii) the GPS Contractor must provide to the process server or the Department upon request, and to any other party according to an appropriate order or subpoena, the process server's electronic record [following information as an MS Excel spreadsheet] in [a] the format provided by the Department on its website,:

(a) Plaintiff or petitioner, which must be specified by the last name of the first plaintiff, or, if not a natural person, the name of the entity, except that the field may contain the name of every plaintiff or petitioner in the case, provided that the entire record is searchable by a wildcard search of the name of any plaintiff or petitioner;

(b) Defendant or respondent, which must be specified by the last name of the first defendant, or, if not a natural person, the name

of the entity, except that the field may contain the name of every defendant or respondent in the case, provided that the entire record is searchable by a wildcard search of the name of any defendant or respondent;

(c) the full index number, entered with all information necessary to identify the case, such as XXXXXX/XX, unless the case is a Civil Local matter, in which case, it will include the prefix of CV, CC, LT, MI, NC, RE, SC, or TS;

(d) the date that service was effected or attempted according to the device, entered as MM/DD/YYYY

(e) the time that service was effected or attempted according to the device, entered in military time;

(f) the date that service was effected or attempted according to GPS or cellular signals, entered as MM/DD/YYYY;

(g) the time that service was effected or attempted according to GPS or cellular signals, entered as military time;

(h) the location where service was effected or attempted, which must include building number, street name, city, ZIP code, which must be five digits, and latitudinal and longitudinal coordinates returned by the GPS device. All address information must be CASS (Coding Accuracy Support System) processed to insure its accuracy with software graded to be CASS Certified by the National Customer Support Center of the United States Postal Service;

(i) the name of the intended recipient of the process, which must be entered in two data fields such that the first data field is the last name of the intended recipient, or, if not a natural person, the name of the entity, and the second data field is the first name of the intended recipient if a natural person;

(j) the name of the person to whom process was delivered, which must be entered in two data fields such that the first data field is the last name of the person, and the second data field is the first name of the person; and

(k) the DCWP license number of the process server, specified as a seven-digit number, where the first number must be zero if the process server's license number is less than seven digits, the DCWP license number of the process serving agency from whom the process was received or, if not received from a process serving agency, the name of such other person or firm from whom the process served was received.]

(b) *Provision of Equipment and Services by Process Serving Agency.* A process serving agency licensed according to this subchapter may provide to licensed process servers the device and services required by subparagraph (a) according to a contract with an independent third party. For purposes of this Rule, a third party will not be considered independent if any officer or owner of ten percent or more of the shares of the licensed process serving agency has any interest, direct or indirect, in the third party.

(c) *Report to Department.*

(1) Within sixty days after the effective date of this Rule a licensed process server must submit to the Department in a form approved by the Commissioner a certification that he or she has secured the contract required by this Rule and identifying the name, address and account number of the GPS Contractor(s) providing the required device and services. After sixty days after the effective date of this Rule, no process server license will be issued or renewed unless the applicant submits such a certificate.

(2) A licensed process server must submit to the Department an amended certification within two days of entering into a contract with a different GPS Contractor.

(3) In place of submitting the certificates required by the preceding provisions, the licensed process server may submit a certification in a form approved by the Commissioner affirmed by an owner or officer of a licensed process serving agency that the device and services the process server is required to obtain are provided by the agency under a contract with an independent third party.

(d) *Compliance with all laws.* Compliance with the requirements of this Rule does not relieve a licensed process server of the obligation to make or maintain records required by any other federal, state, or local law, rule or regulation.

Section 3. Section 2-234 of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-234 Duty to Comply with Law.

The licensee shall at all times strictly and promptly conform to all laws, rules, regulations and requirements of the federal, state and municipal authorities relating to the conduct of licensees and the service of process in the State of New York and the preparation,

notarization and filing of affidavits of service; and the preparation and filing of affirmations of service and other documents, now in force or hereafter adopted during any license period.

Section 4. Section 2-235 of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-235 Preparation of Affidavits of Service or Affirmations of Service.

(a) [No] A licensee may not sign [or] an affirmation of service or notarize or cause to be signed or notarized an affidavit of service until all factual averments have been set forth. [The licensee must not make a false statement in an affidavit of service] The licensee must include [his/her] their license number on all affidavits of service and affirmations of service signed by [him/her] them. On [all] each affidavit[s] of service and affirmation of service, the licensee must: (1) specify the papers served; the person who was served; the individual who was delivered service; the date, time and address or place of service; and the manner of service; and (2) set forth facts showing that service was made in an authorized manner. A process server purporting to serve a business entity by delivery of papers to an individual that the process server, upon personal knowledge, avers in the affidavit of service or affirmation of service to be the "agent," "managing agent" or "general agent," or other individual authorized to accept service, also must state in the affidavit of service or affirmation of service, at a minimum: (1) that the process server inquired if that individual was authorized to accept service and received an affirmative response; (2) that the process server inquired of the individual their name and job or responsibilities and the individual's responses; and (3) facts confirming or explaining the statement that the process server knew the individual served was the type of agent specified in the affidavit of service or affirmation of service. The licensee must maintain a copy of [every] each affidavit of service and affirmation of service for at least seven years in electronic form or as a paper copy.

(b) A licensee must not make any false statement in an affidavit of service or affirmation of service.

(c) The commissioner may deny any license application or refuse to renew any license, and, after due notice and opportunity to be heard, may suspend or revoke such license, if the applicant or person holding such license, or where applicable, any of its officers, principals, directors, members, managers, employees, or stockholders owning ten percent or more of the outstanding stock of the corporation, has been found, in connection with the applicant's or licensee's business, to have made a false statement in an affirmation of service or affidavit of service.

Section 5: Chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended by adding a new section 2-235a, to read as follows:

§ 2-235a Duty To Testify Truthfully

(a) A licensee may not make any other false statement orally or in writing under oath or affirmation before any court, body, agency, public servant, or other person authorized by law to administer an oath, where the false statement is material to the action, proceeding or matter in which it is made.

(b) The commissioner may deny any license application or refuse to renew any license, and, after due notice and opportunity to be heard, may suspend or revoke such license, if the applicant or person holding such license, or where applicable, any of its officers, principals, directors, members, managers, employees, or stockholders owning ten percent or more of the outstanding stock of the corporation, has been found, in connection with the applicant's or licensee's business, to have made such a false statement.

Section 6: Section 2-236 of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-236 Duty to Report Hearings Contesting Service.

(a) Whenever a process server or process serving agency receives any type of notice, including an oral communication, that a court has scheduled a hearing to determine whether service of process made or assigned by such licensee was effective, the licensee must submit a report to the Department in the manner designated by the Department on its website within ten days of receiving such notice. Such written report must include:

- (1) the title and index number of the action;
- (2) the court and the judge before whom the hearing is scheduled;
- (3) the date(s) of the hearing; and
- (4) the name and license number of every licensee who effected service or assigned or distributed the process for service.

(b) On request, such licensee must provide copies of all records, including but not limited to, routing sheets, the pages of the licensee's log book for each day on which service of the process in issue was attempted or effected, and all affidavits of service and affirmations of service, pertaining to the contested service.

(c) (1) The licensee must attempt to learn the result of such hearing, including any judicial order or voluntary settlement resolving the challenge to service of process, by making a written or email request to the party on whose behalf the challenged service of process was made or the party's attorney for a written report of the result of the hearing. Sixty days after the date of the scheduled hearing, if the party or its attorney has not provided to the licensee a written report of the result of such hearing, the licensee must search for the result in the file in the office of the clerk of the court where such hearing was scheduled to occur. If the clerk's file does not contain a result sixty days after the hearing, the licensee must search for the result in the clerk's file ninety days after the scheduled date of such hearing.

(2) The licensee must report to the Department in the manner designated by the Department on its website (i) within ten days of learning the result, or (ii) that it made attempts to learn the result and was unable to do so not later than one-hundred days after the scheduled date of such hearing.

Section 7: Section 2-240 of chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-240 Audits.

(a) Pursuant to subdivision c of § 20-406.3 of the Administrative Code, the Department may audit any process server that has served at least one summons, subpoena, notice, citation or other process, directing an appearance or response to a legal action, legal proceeding or administrative proceeding that is subject to the provisions of section 110 of the civil court act. In conducting such an audit, the Department may issue a subpoena by email to a process server for the period identified by the Department in such subpoena for the following records no longer than two months:

(1) Records that a process server is required to maintain pursuant to 6 RCNY § 2-233(a);

(2) Affidavits of service and affirmations of service filed with a court by a process server or on behalf of a process server related to service;

(3) Records of the GPS location, time and date of attempted or effected service of process made pursuant to 6 RCNY § 2-233(b) (2); and

(4) Documents sufficient to identify all traverse hearings scheduled to occur, whether or not held, by any court, including courts outside of New York City, concerning process served or attempted to be served, and any result of such hearings.

(b) Records described by paragraphs one through three of subdivision a of this section must be produced in electronic form, unless otherwise specified by the Department, and records described by paragraph four of subdivision a of this section may be produced in paper or electronic form. Records described in paragraph two of subdivision a of this section must be produced in chronological order.

(c) A process server must comply with each document production demand in a subpoena from the Department within 20 days of the date on which the subpoena was issued, provided that the monetary penalties authorized by 6 RCNY § 6-30 for violation of 6 RCNY § 2-240 will not apply while such subpoena is the subject of a pending judicial proceeding. Each failure to comply with a document production demand in a subpoena is a separate violation.

(d) By February 1st and August 1st of each calendar year, a process server must submit, by electronic means, a certification to the Department stating whether it has served at least one summons, subpoena, notice, citation or other process, directing an appearance or response to a legal action, legal proceeding or administrative proceeding that is subject to the provisions of section 110 of the civil court act in the most recent six-month period, as follows: the February 1st certification must cover the six-month period from July through December of the previous year; the August 1st certification must cover the six-month period from January through June of the current year.

(e) Nothing in this section limits the Department's authority to request or inspect records or information pursuant to any other provisions of law or rule, including, but not limited to, the Commissioner's authority to conduct audits of process servers and process serving agencies pursuant to the first sentence of subdivision c of § 20-406.3 of the Administrative Code.

(f) A process server or process serving agency must produce [all] each subpoenaed or requested document[s] and record[s] they are required to maintain pursuant to law or rule, even where they

maintain their records with a third party. Each failure to comply is a separate violation.

Section 8: This rule takes effect on March 1, 2025.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF FINAL RULE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION by Section 1403(c) of the New York City Charter and Section 24-523(e) of the New York City Administrative Code, that the Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") is adopting a rule governing house/site connections to the sewer system. These amendments were proposed and published in the City Record on October 1, 2024 and a public hearing was held on October 31, 2024. No substantive comments were received.

Statement of Basis and Purpose

The New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP or Department) is amending its rules governing house/site connections to the sewer system (Chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York (RCNY)) to clarify certain standards for installation of sewer connections.

Section 1403(b-1) of the Charter of the City of New York provides that the Commissioner of Environmental Protection ("Commissioner") "shall have charge and control over the location, construction, alteration, repair, maintenance and operation of all sewers including intercepting sewers and sewage disposal plants, and of all matters in the several boroughs relating to public sewers and drainage, and shall initiate and make all plans for drainage and shall have charge of all public and private sewers in accordance with such plans; and shall have charge of the management, care and maintenance of sewer and drainage systems therein." Title 24 of the Administrative Code of the city of New York, Chapter 5-Section 24-508 and 24-509 establishes that the DEP commissioner develops the rules related to the connections made to private and public sewers and drains.

The amendments to Chapter 31 add explicit connection configurations where none were defined previously, reconfigure how certain larger connections connect to sewers, prevent the creation of unnecessary structures in DEP facilities, and clarify certain rules currently enforced in accordance with standard practices.

The proposed amendments to §31-05 Standards for Installation of Sewer Connections:

- Specify the appropriate connection method for six (6) inch connections to six (6) inch sewers and eight (8) inch connections to ten (10) inch sewers, as the appropriate connection size had not previously been defined in the rules.
- Reconfigure when core drill-in connections are allowed to be made to sewers of varying sizes in order to allow for core drill-in connections where currently a manhole connection is required.
- Clarify that connections that are proposed to be larger than 16" require a chamber to be built on the sewer in accordance with DEP standards.
- Ban the building of new manholes on DEP sewers in close proximity to existing manholes (within fifty (50) feet of an existing manhole) except in extraordinary circumstances.
- Clarify that for any site connection proposals where an existing, functional, connection is reused, that the connection is required to be the minimum connection size as appropriate for the borough.
- Clarify that connections may not be larger than the sewers to which they are proposed to connect.
- Clarify that connections may be reused for any property, not just those for site connection proposals for a 1-, 2-, or 3-family dwelling.

Material being deleted is shown below in [brackets] and material being added is underlined

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Section 1. Subdivision (b) of section 31-01 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended by adding new

definitions of “bell,” “protrusion” and “section,” in alphabetical order, to read as follows:

Bell. “Bell” means the end of the pipe, which is larger than the rest of the pipe.

Protrusion. “Protrusion” means an extension of the sewer connection beyond the inner wall of the sewer.

Section. “Section” means the area of sewer pipe from existing bell to bell.

§ 2. Paragraph (6) of subdivision (b) of section 31-02 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(6) All existing and proposed sewer connections shall be shown on the site plan and supporting documents. The minimum size of pipe for proposed or reused connections to the sewer system shall be an eight (8) inch pipe in the Borough of Manhattan and a six (6) inch pipe in all other Boroughs. The diameter of a sewer service connection may never be larger than the diameter of the sewer to which it is connecting.

§ 3. Section 31-02 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended by adding a new subdivision (c), to read as follows:

(c) (1) System Availability: The Department will determine the sewer availability based on the following requirements. The Department shall determine that connection is feasible if:

1. the sewer is considered a Department asset;
2. the sewer is of adequate capacity to receive all sewage flowing from the tributary area;
3. the sewer is in adequate physical condition to receive such flow;
4. no physical obstacles exist, between the boundaries of the lot or tract of land on which the building is located and the sewer, which would make connection to the sewer impracticable;
5. the sewer is located in the same drainage area as all or most of the lot or tract of land on which the building is located; and
6. no other factor reasonably related to the conveyance of flow from the building to the sewer would make such connection impracticable or undesirable as a proper means of sewage disposal.

(2) Sanitary flow: A public sanitary sewer or combined sewer for the purpose of conveying sewage, shall be deemed available to a one, two and three family dwelling, if a property line of such dwelling is within one hundred feet (measured along a street or right-of-way) of the sewer. A public sanitary sewer or combined sewer for the purpose of conveying sewage, shall be deemed available to a building in which plumbing fixtures are installed, except to a one, two and three family dwelling, if a property line of such building is within five hundred feet (measured along a street, or right-of-way) of the sewer.

(3) Storm flow: A public storm or combined sewer for the purpose of conveying stormwater shall be deemed available in accordance with Administrative Code 24-526.

§ 4. Paragraph (2) of subdivision (d) of section 31-04 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(2) Reuse of Plugged Connection and Reuse of Existing Connection. [For one, two or three family dwellings, permits] Permits for unplugging and reuse of a plugged sewer connection, or reuse of an existing sewer connection will be issued upon:

§ 5. Subdivision (a) of section 31-05 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(a) General Requirements. All new sewer connections shall [be in compliance] comply with this Rule. All work must be done in such a way that the connection to the sewer will not result in any protrusion beyond the internal wall of the sewer.

§ 6. Paragraph (7) of subdivision (d) of section 31-05 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(7) In cases where no spurs exist, or connection to an existing spur is not feasible, one of the following methods shall be used:

(i) For six (6) inch diameter sewer connections to six (6) inch diameter sewers or drains, or eight (8) inch diameter sewer connections to eight (8) inch diameter sewers or drains; when connecting to clay sewers, three (3) sections of the existing sewer or drain shall be replaced with two (2) straight pipe sections and a central spur piece; when connecting to sewers or drains of other materials, minimum one section shall be replaced with three (3) shorter segments with minimum length of four (4) feet each.

(ii) For six (6) inch diameter sewer connections to eight (8) inch diameter sewers or drains, or eight (8) inch diameter sewer connections to ten (10) inch diameter sewers or drains, if the existing eight (8) or ten (10) inch diameter sewer or drain is not supported by a concrete

cradle, the connection method described in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph (7) shall apply. For sewers or drains on concrete cradles, a minimum of [four (4)] two (2) feet in length of the existing sewer or drain on either side of the point of connection shall be encased in concrete [from the point of connection]. The concrete encasement shall follow Department sewer design standards. The concrete shall be allowed to set for forty-eight (48) hours, after which time, core drilling shall be performed.

(iii) Core drilling to install a spur into an existing sewer or drain shall only be performed with an approved coring machine. Such coring shall be made at the one (1) or two (2) o'clock or ten (10) to eleven (11) o'clock position as described in paragraph (9) of this subdivision (b). The cored portion of the sewer shall be retained and submitted to the Inspector. Core drilling shall only be permitted in the following circumstances: (A) where the new sewer connection is six (6) inches in diameter and the existing sewer or drain is ten (10) inches in diameter or larger; (B) where the new sewer connection is eight (8) inches in diameter and the existing sewer or drain is twelve (12) inches in diameter or larger; (C) where the new sewer connection is ten (10) inches in diameter and the existing sewer or drain is [twenty-four (24)] fifteen (15) inches in diameter or larger[.]; (D) where the new sewer connection is twelve (12) inches in diameter and the existing sewer or drain is eighteen (18) inches in diameter or larger; and (E) where the new sewer connection is fifteen (15) or sixteen (16) inches in diameter and the existing sewer or drain is thirty (30) inches in diameter or larger.

(iv) Any sewer connection ten (10) inches in diameter to existing sewers or drains less than 15 (fifteen) inches in diameter; or sewer connection twelve (12) inches in diameter [or larger] to existing sewers or drains less than [forty-eight (48)] eighteen (18) inches in diameter; or sewer connection fifteen (15) or sixteen (16) inches in diameter to existing sewers or drains less than thirty (30) inches in diameter, shall be made only to an existing or proposed manhole. For sewer connections larger than [eighteen (18)] sixteen (16) inches in diameter, the applicant shall submit a detail of the proposed method of connection to the Department for review and approval, and a manhole must be constructed in accordance with Department standards to accommodate the connection. When a non-standard manhole is required, an additional Department review is required. No new manhole may be built on a Department sewer within 50' of an existing manhole without proof of substantial hardship.

§ 7. Paragraph (1) of subdivision (a) of section 31-07 of chapter 31 of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended, and a new paragraph (2) is added, to read as follows:

(1) All sewer connections, including new connections, relays/repairs, plugs, catch basin and catch basin connections, and seepage basins shall be inspected and approved by [an] a Department Inspector unless the Department accepts photographic or video verification that the work meets Department standards.

(2) For connection work in the vicinity of the sewer, all work must be done in such a way that connections to the sewer will not result in any protrusions beyond the internal wall of the sewer. The Department must be able to confirm by inspection during installation or by a permittee-provided photographic or televised inspection of the sewer, as required and specified by the department, that there are no protrusions into the sewer wall beyond the internal wall of the sewer.

(A) This restriction shall not apply to a new transfer station that is located at or adjacent to a rail yard, rail spur, industrial track or vessel facility, provided that at least ninety percent of the solid waste received is subsequently transported from the transfer station by rail or vessel.

(B) Any new transfer stations operating a truck-to-truck facility must obtain a corresponding reduction (offset) in the lawful daily permitted throughput capacity at a transfer station within the same community district at a rate of one ton for every new ton of capacity. Such reduction must be of the same type of solid waste (putrescible for putrescible, construction and demolition debris for construction and demolition debris, or fill material for fill material).

(C) Any application for a new putrescible or construction and demolition debris transfer stations located at or adjacent to a rail yard, rail spur, industrial track or vessel facility, and where at least ninety percent of the solid waste received is subsequently transported from the transfer station by rail or vessel, must obtain a corresponding reduction (offset) in the lawful daily permitted throughput capacity at a putrescible or construction and demolition debris transfer station within the same community district at a rate of one ton for every new ton of capacity.

(D) Any transfer station that is lawfully operating that is located at least 500 feet from a residential district, hospital, public park or school may increase its lawful daily permitted throughput capacity only if such owner/operator obtains a corresponding reduction (offset) in the lawful daily permitted throughput capacity at a transfer station located in the same community district at a rate of one ton for every new ton of capacity. Such reduction must be of the same type of solid waste (putrescible for putrescible, construction and demolition debris for construction and demolition debris, or fill material for fill material).

(E) Any putrescible or construction and demolition debris transfer station that is lawfully operating at or adjacent to a rail yard, rail spur, industrial track or vessel facility where at least ninety percent of the solid waste received is subsequently transported from the transfer station by rail or vessel, may increase its lawful daily permitted throughput capacity provided that the owner/operator obtains a corresponding reduction (offset) in the lawful daily permitted throughput capacity at a putrescible or construction and demolition debris transfer station within the same community district at a rate of one ton for every new ton of capacity.

(F) Any transfer station that is lawfully operating may increase its lawful daily permitted throughput capacity, subject to Department review and approval, provided that it is located at least 500 feet from a residential district, hospital, public park or school. This restriction shall not apply to a transfer station that is located at or adjacent to a rail yard, rail spur, industrial track or vessel facility, provided that at least ninety percent of the solid waste received is subsequently transported from the transfer station by rail or vessel.

(G) Any transfer station that is lawfully operating may increase its lawful daily permitted throughput capacity, subject to Department review and approval, provided that it is located at least 400 feet from a residential district, hospital, public park or school. This restriction shall not apply to a transfer station that is located at or adjacent to a rail yard, rail spur, industrial track or vessel facility, provided that at least ninety percent of the solid waste received is subsequently transported from the transfer station by rail or vessel.

(H) Any new transfer station shall not be located in an M1 district if the M1 districts in such community district cumulatively contain three or more lawfully operating transfer stations.
