Support and Outreach refers to not-for-profit organizations that offer help, including but not limited to:

- Preparation for the TASC test (formerly, GED);
- Enrollment in a professional certification program (e.g., OSHA);
- Job training and placement;
- Applying for city or state ID; and
- Housing assistance.

Law enforcement refers to local, state, and federal agencies, including prosecutors, corrections, and community supervision.

Members of these groups are shooting people and are at the greatest risk of being shot and killed.

- We want to keep you alive, safe, and out of prison.

- We will help any group member who asks.
