NYC EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ISSUES TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR FRIDAY PM RUSH

September 20, 2019 — The New York City Emergency Management Department has issued a travel advisory for Lower Manhattan for the Friday evening commute. Due to the ongoing Climate Strike demonstration, expect large crowds, intermittent road closures, traffic delays, and a presence of emergency personnel in Lower Manhattan. Consider alternate routes and allow for additional travel time.
