#### FIRST DISTRICT, BOROUGH OF RICHMOND.

The Local Board, First District, Borough or Richmond, The City of New York, mer at the Borough Office, in the First National Bank Building, at St. George, in said borough, on Saturday Inne 2, 1900, at 10 o'clock in the foremon.

about one hundred and sixty-four feet northeasterly from the intersection of Occident avenue with said Ward avenue, and to be generally parallel with the present direction of Louis street; and Whereas, By letter of Hon. Henry P.
