




Thank you to all who participated in last week's **Quiz of the Week**. The correct answer is: **B) Red crepe paper poppies**.



1. Complete the NYC CERT Mentor Program form to let us know if you'd like to be a mentor or mentee.






FEMA Region 2 (R2) Webinar **Catalog** includes all recorded webinars.


