




I. Population Change: Total Population in DOC Custody

Total DOC Population by Custody Status October 9, 2021 – October 15, 2021






City Sentenced Population by Custody Status October 9, 2021 – October 15, 2021

Pretrial Population by Custody Status October 9, 2021 – October 15, 2021







Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 October 9 – October 15, 2021






Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody March 17, 2020 – October 15, 2021








Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 – October 15, 2021


Number and Percent of Open Units Above and Below 50% Capacity by Housing Category October 14, 2021
