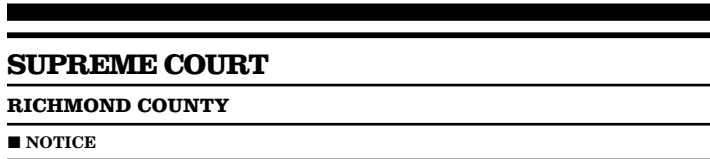

- DCWP’s offer to an applicant will be void, the applicant removed from the application pool, and an offer made to the applicant with the next Priority Number in the following situations:
  - Applicant fails to submit a complete application within the allotted time.
  - DCWP denies the application because applicant previously had a revoked Tobacco Retail Dealer license or a Tobacco Retail Dealer license has already been issued to the specific premises location.
