NYC Sanitation and NYC Emergency Management Commissioners to Hold Snow Briefing

Briefing to include critical information for New Yorkers ahead of winter weather

EVENT DATE: TODAY, January 6, 2022 – The New York City Department of Sanitation and New York City Emergency Management will hold a briefing ahead of winter weather. Based on current forecasts, the Departments expect snowfall beginning Thursday evening, with up to 6 inches possible through the overnight hours and into Friday afternoon. All winter weather information and information about the City's response to the storm can be found by visiting the City's Severe Weather website at www.nyc.gov/severeweather, or by calling 311.

WHERE: Manhattan 1/2/5 Garage, 353 Spring St., 10013. Parking available on Spring, Washington, or Canal. Members of the press may meet a City employee at the corner of Spring and West Streets, who will bring them inside. Masks required.

WHEN: Briefing to begin promptly at 3pm. Please arrive slightly earlier to allow time to come in the elevator.

KEY PERSONNEL: DSNY Commissioner Edward Grayson, NYCEM First Deputy Commissioner Christina Farrell. ASL interpretation and Spanish-language interviews available.

VISUALS: Commissioners will speak in front of multiple pieces of snow-fighting equipment.
