

Gas Piping Work Civil Penalty Amnesty Program

NYC Building's Gas Piping Work Civil Penalty Amnesty Program starts next Wednesday, April 5, 2017. During this 6-month amnesty period the Department will waive the civil penalties associated with certain previously issued violations for work without a permit on gas piping systems, provided that the owner obtains the proper DOB permit and completes the job. Take advantage of this amnesty period to legalize your gas piping work and reduce the fines you owe to the City.

1 RCNY 104-01 (effective 03.16.17) The amendments more accurately reflect the current qualification process for licensees, expand the fitness requirements to additional license types, and add restrictions on the location of contractors businesses within the city.

Proposed Amendment of Licensing Rules Relating to Riggers, Sign Hangers, and Elevator Inspection Agencies

The Department of Buildings (DOB) is proposing to amend its rules relating to reinstatement of license, continuing education requirements, and supervisory responsibilities of riggers and sign hangers and to repeal its rules regarding private elevator inspection agencies and climber or tower crane rigger licenses.
