New York City had its first extreme heat wave this past week. Extreme heat is a serious threat, and New Yorkers need to be extra careful during hot summer months.








CERT at I.S. 96 Community Resource Fair

THINGS TO KNOW



How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:

- Event organizer submits an official request using the <u>NYC CERT External Request Form</u>.
- NYC CERT Leadership should not submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this <u>Event</u> <u>Request form</u>

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the NYC CERT Event Calendar

with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


