## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 298**

## EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER TO SUSPEND ZONING PROVISIONS TO FACILITATE RECONSTRUCTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ENHANCED FLOOD RESISTANT CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

## April 11, 2013

WHEREAS, Executive Order 282, issued March 27, 2013, contains a proclamation extending a state of emergency in the City of New York, and such proclamation remains in effect for a period not to exceed thirty days or until rescinded, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, the Governor issued a declaration of emergency for all counties in the State of New York, including the City of New York, and such declaration remains in effect for a period not to exceed six months or until rescinded, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 233, issued February 5, 2013, contains an emergency order to

suspend zoning provisions to facilitate reconstruction in accordance with enhanced flood resistant construction standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

§ 1. The emergency order to suspend zoning provisions to facilitate reconstruction in accordance with enhanced flood resistant construction standards set forth in Executive Order 233 is hereby extended for five days.

§ 2. This Order shall take effect immediately. It shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.
