Other units access the Special Victims Unit case management system in the course of official duties.

Examples of this proper access include other units investigating the crime, units involved in securing or processing evidence, units that analyze crimes to determine whether a crime pattern may be occurring, and units involved in apprehending the perpetrator(s) of such crime. Additionally, this audit included as "other" units that had initial or concurrent investigative responsibility for cases which were later investigated by SVU.

The following are examples of units that may access SVU cases for valid reasons:

Police Commissioner's Office

Chief of Department

Internal Affairs Bureau

Chief of Crime Control Strategies

Patrol Services Bureau (e.g., precinct commanding officer, precinct domestic violence officer)

Detective Bureau (e.g., precinct detective squad, Crime Scene Unit, Warrants Section)

Transit Bureau

Deputy Commissioner of Public Information
