In March 2020, in-person visitation in the city's jails was suspended due to COVID-19 pandemic. The Department instituted televisitation in order to keep people in custody connected to their loved ones. In-person visits resumed June 25th, 2021. The table below describes both televisits and in-person visits that took place during the reporting period.
