- Refusing service to anyone on the basis of their perceived or actual sexual orientation.
- Refusing to hire or firing anyone on the basis of their perceived or actual sexual orientation.
- Refusing to rent to someone on the basis of their perceived or actual sexual orientation.
- Harassing someone on the basis of their perceived or actual sexual orientation.
