EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 82

REVOCATION OF BAN ON NON-ESSENTIAL FOREIGN TRAVEL IN RESPONSE TO
THE CORONAVIRUS

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 55 prohibited employees of City agencies from non-essential foreign travel for official City business, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, this ban on non-essential foreign travel is no longer necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York:

Section 1. I hereby revoke Executive Order No. 55, dated March 8, 2020.

§ 2. This order shall take effect immediately.
