Advanced Life Support - 2 vials of 2mg/2ml each vial, IV/IN/IM (Carried in 1 medication insert) for a total of 4mg/4ml.

Basic Life Support - 2 vials of 2mg/2ml each vial/dose IN, and 2 atomizers, for a total of 4mg/4ml.

Certified First Responder - 2 vials 2mg/2ml each vial/dose IN.

On hand at Pharmacy – 2,000 vials (2mg/2ml each).

- The above units carry 2 atomizer devices each to dispense Naloxone.
- ALS and BLS units are equipped with two DOH Leave Behind Kits for distribution to patients when applicable. Each kit includes two 4mg/each spray for a total of 8mg.
