# Local Law 86: Quarterly and Semi-Annual Reporting of Individuals in DOC Custody

Second Quarter, 2018

Numbers are generated by the Department of Correction and New York Police Department and are reported to, and compiled by, the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice. Charts 1, 3, 14, and 15 are reported on a quarterly basis, and charts 2, 4-13, and 16 are reported semi-annually.

#### **DOC** population data is reported in two different formats:

<u>Snapshot</u>: the population of individuals in DOC custody on a given day <u>Admissions</u>: a cumulative measure of individuals admitted to DOC custody over time

# **Changes from Previous Reporting Cycles**

Changes Starting in Q1 2017:

Pretrial detainees with open parole violations were previously treated as pretrial detainees due to data availability. However, per statute requirements beginning with this report, all individuals with open cases and a parole warrant are now counted as parole violators.

The category amount pending was added to paragraph 13 for individuals who have had bail posted but are awaiting surety review to determine if the source of the funds is legitimate.
