EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9

March 14, 1974

REGULATIONS GOVERNING CASH PAYMENTS FOR UNUSED ACCRUED ANNUAL LEAVE AND UNUSED ACCRUED COMPENSATORY TIME ON DEATH OF CERTAIN SANITATION SERVICE EMPLOYEES WHILE IN THE CITY'S EMPLOY.

Whereas, Contracts for the period January 1, 1971 to June 30, 1973 between The City of New York and the respective exclusive bargaining representative of employees in the classes of positions listed below provided, effective January 1, 1971, that certain cash payments for unused accrued leave and unused accrued compensatory time shall be made if such employee dies while employed by the city:

- Sanitation Man
- Assistant Foreman
- Foreman
- District Superintendent
- Senior Superintendent

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of The City of New York, it is hereby ordered that the following Regulations Governing Cash Payments for Unused Accrued Annual Leave and Unused Accrued Compensatory Time on Death of such an Employee while in the City's employ be and the same are hereby established:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1971, in the case of an incumbent of a position in a class of positions listed above, the beneficiary designated under the Retirement System or, if
