Since the bombing of the Oklahoma Federal Building, the student body of M.S. 181 has been deeply concerned with the consequences of terrorist activities that have touched members of its student body. On September 11, a former MS 181 student, Christopher Regenhart, a rookie fireman, was killed in the attack on the World Trade Center, and at that time the student government cleared a spot and planted a tree in his memory. In November 2004 a popular Co-Op City Firefighter, Christian Engeldrum, who had been a sergeant to one of MS 181's teachers in his squad lost his life fighting in Iraq. A majority of MS 181's students live in Co-Op City and Mr. Engeldrum was a popular member of the community.

Wishing to continue the tradition of honoring MS181 students and their families who had suffered losses, the student body submitted a SCAF grant request. (SCAF) awarded the School \$475 to help with the planting of a *Garden of Heroes.* MS181 contacted DEP's Office of
