Dear Mayor de Blasio:

Please be advised that the NYC Office of Labor Relations (OLR) does not have any capital projects in progress or in any stage of planning, nor do any of OLR's responsibilities pertain to the planning, advancement or oversight of City capital projects. Accordingly, OLR has no capital projects to report on for purposes of the following provisions under the NYC Charter:

- Charter § 219(d), requiring each agency to prepare and submit periodic reports in regard to the progress of its capital projects.
- Charter § 222(a) requiring a report on the proposed scope of capital projects or explanation of any delay.
