re: Local Law 67 of 2022: Park and Playground Inspections

Dear Speaker Adams:

Pursuant to Local Law 67 of 2022, The New York City Department of Parks and Recreation is required to submit a report to the Council regarding park features under the jurisdiction of the department that were found to receive an unacceptable rating three or more times during a six-month period, resulting from inspections conducted by the department.

Between January 1, 2025, and June 30, 2025, the below sites received three or more unacceptable ratings ("U," "U/S") during internal inspections:
