Pursuant to Local Law 67 of 2022, The New York City Department of Parks and Recreation is required to submit a report to the Council regarding park features under the jurisdiction of the department that were found to receive an unacceptable rating three or more times during a sixmonth period, resulting from inspections conducted by the department.
