EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 47

January 4 , 1993

OFFICE OF FILM, THEATRE AND  
BROADCASTING

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Continuation of Office of Film, Theatre and Broadcasting. There is continued within the Office of the Mayor an Office of Film, Theatre and Broadcasting, to be headed by a commissioner who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Mayor. The commissioner shall report to and be directly accountable to the Deputy Mayor for Finance and Economic Development.

§ 2. Scope of Duties. The Office of Film, Theatre and Broadcasting shall:

- a. Issue all permits required for film and television production and for still photography shoots in the City.
- b. Provide information and assistance necessary to enable filmmakers and broadcasters to operate in the City.
- c. Develop programs and activities designed to encourage theatrical production and attendance in the City.
- d. Perform such other functions as are deemed necessary by the commissioner to facilitate film, theater and television production in the City.

§ 3. Cooperation and Assistance. The heads of all City departments and agencies, including the Police Department, the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Department of Transportation, shall cooperate with and assist the Office of Film, Theatre and Broadcasting in carrying out its responsibilities under this Order.

§ 4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
