Shelters can be: (a) provider-owned and provider-operated; (b) city-owned and city-operated; (c) city-owned and provider-operated; or (d) privately-owned, and provider-operated under lease with the building owner. Where shelter service providers do not own the buildings they occupy, their responsibility for responding to violations may vary in accordance with their lease terms.
- 2) Administrative processes relating to curing violations, including but not limited to re-inspection of corrected conditions, and posting updated information on the Scorecard can take up to 90 days and changes may not be immediately reflected.
