IN THE MATTER OF an application submitted by the Housing Options and Geriatric Association Resources, Inc. (H.O.G.A.R, Inc., the "Applicant"), proposes a series of land-use actions to rezone an existing R6 zoning district to an R7-2 zoning district in the Morrisania neighborhood within Bronx Community District 3. The project area is located at the corner of East 161st Street and Eagle Avenue and consists of Block 2620, Lots 47, 48, 49, 50 and 56 (the "Proposed Project Area").

The proposed actions will facilitate the development of a new eleven story plus cellular and sub-cellular use group 3 community facility building (philanthropic or non-profit institution with sleeping accommodations). ("the proposed development"), at 893 Eagle Avenue (Block 2620, Lots 49, 50, 52 and 56) (the Proposed Development Site) The proposed development will have a floor area of approximately 55,342 square feet (6.18 FAR) and includes a total of 83 affordable and supportive housing units. The proposed development will have entrances on both East 161st Street and Eagle Avenue. The sub-cellar, which is located at grade level East 161st Street and the cellar levels, will contain a lobby, counseling offices and multipurpose room, to serve the residents of the building.
