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Executive Director's Monthly Report June 2025 (Statistics for May 2025)

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Executive Summary

The Civilian Complaint Review Board ("CCRB") is an independent municipal Agency that investigates complaints of NYPD misconduct. Every month, the CCRB prepares an Executive Director report for its public meeting. Data for May 2025 included the following highlights:

- 1) Of the cases in the CCRB active investigations docket, 49% have been open for 4 months or fewer, and 65% have been open for 7 months or fewer (page 10). In May, the CCRB opened 480 new cases (page 4), and currently has a total open docket of 2,977 cases (page 11).
- 2) The CCRB substantiated allegations in 44% of its fully investigated cases in May (page 17).
- 3) The CCRB fully investigated 55% of the cases it closed in May (page 14).
- 4) For May, investigations using video evidence resulted in substantiated allegations in 44% of cases compared to 20% of cases in which video was not available (page 24).
- 5) The Monthly Report includes a breakdown of complaints and substantiations by NYPD precinct and borough of occurrence (pages 5-6, 40-57).
- 6) In May the Police Commissioner finalized 22 decision(s) against police officers in Administrative Prosecution Unit (APU) cases (page 30). The CCRB's APU prosecutes the most serious allegations of misconduct. The APU conducted 4 trials against members of the NYPD year-to-date; no trials were conducted against respondent officers in May.

The CCRB is committed to producing monthly reports that are valuable to the public, and welcomes feedback on how to make its data more accessible.

Glossary

In this glossary we have included a list of terms that regularly appear in our reports.

Allegation: An allegation is a specific act of misconduct. The same "complaint" can have multiple allegations – excessive force and discourteous language, for example. Each allegation is reviewed separately during an investigation.

APU: The Administrative Prosecution Unit is the division of the CCRB that has prosecuted "charges" cases since April 2013, after the signing of a 2012 Memorandum of Understanding between the CCRB and NYPD.

Board Panel: The "Board" of the CCRB has 15 members. Following a completed investigation by the CCRB staff, three Board members, sitting as a Board Panel, will make a finding on whether misconduct occurred and will make a recommendation on what level of penalty should follow.

Case/Complaint: For the purposes of CCRB data, a "case" or "complaint" is defined as any incident within the Agency's jurisdiction, brought to resolution by the CCRB.

Disposition: The Board's finding as to the outcome of a case (i.e. if misconduct occurred).

FADO: Under the City Charter, the CCRB has jurisdiction to investigate the following categories of police misconduct: Force, Abuse of Authority, Discourtesy and Offensive Language, collectively known as "FADO".

FADO&U: A ballot measure revising the New York City Charter, which passed on November 5, 2019, authorized the CCRB to investigate the truthfulness of an official statement made by a subject officer during a CCRB investigation into a FADO allegation. This expanded jurisdiction—Force, Abuse of Authority, Discourtesy, Offensive Language, and Untruthful Statements (FADO&U)—went into effect on March 31, 2020.

Intake: CCRB's intake team initially handles complaints from the public. Intake takes complaints that come via live phone calls, voicemails, an online complaint form, or in-person.

Investigation: CCRB investigators gather evidence and interview witnesses to prepare reports on misconduct allegations. An investigation ends when a closing report is prepared detailing the evidence and legal analysis, and the case is given to the Board for disposition.

Mediation: A complainant may mediate his or her case with the subject officer, in lieu of an investigation, with the CCRB providing a neutral, third-party mediator.

Unable to Investigate: A catch-all term, used for reporting purposes only, that refers to cases where the CCRB was unable to conduct an investigation, typically because no statement could be obtained from the complainant/alleged victim. "Unable to Investigate" incorporates the following CCRB dispositions: "Complainant/Alleged Victim Uncooperative", "Complainant/Alleged Victim Unavailable", "Witness Uncooperative", "Witness Unavailable", "Victim Unidentified", "OMB PEG Directive Closure", and "SRAD Closure."

Withdrawn: When the complainant/alleged victim asks that their complaint be withdrawn, the case is closed as "Withdrawn."

Closed Pending Litigation: When a complainant is involved in criminal or civil litigation, and declines to cooperate with an investigation on the advice of their attorney, the complaint disposition is "Closed Pending Litigation."

Complaints Received





Figure 1: Total Intake by Month (January 2024 - May 2025)







Figure 3: New CCRB Complaints by Year (YTD 2010 - YTD 2025)

The CCRB's Intake team processes misconduct complaints from the public and referrals from the NYPD. Under the New York City Charter, the CCRB's jurisdiction is limited to allegations of misconduct related to Force, Abuse of Authority, Discourtesy and Offensive Language. All other complaints are referred to the appropriate agency. Figure 1 refers to all complaints that the CCRB receives and Figures 2 and 3 refer to new cases that remain with the Agency. In May 2025, the CCRB initiated 480 new complaints.

Figure 4: CCRB Complaints Received By Borough of Occurrence (May 2025)




Figure 5: CCRB Complaints Received By Borough of Occurrence (YTD 2025)




Figure 6: CCRB Complaints Received By Precinct of Occurrence (May 2025)

As described in the previous section, the CCRB has jurisdiction over four categories of NYPD misconduct. The charts below show what types of allegations are contained in the CCRB complaints received.




Figure 7: CCRB Complaints Received By Type of Allegation (May 2024 vs. May 2025)




Figure 9: CCRB Complaints Received By Type of Allegation (YTD 2024 vs. YTD 2025)

Figure 15: Number of Active Investigations (January 2024 - May 2025)




Figure 16: Open Docket Analysis




Figure 17: Open Docket Analysis with % Change

Body Worn Camera Footage Requests

Since the widespread roll out of body worn cameras in 2018, the collection of footage from these cameras has become an integral part of CCRB investigations.

The timeliness of the response to BWC footage requests has a direct impact on the length of time it takes to complete an investigation. The longer it takes to fulfill BWC requests, the longer CCRB investigations remain on the open docket.

Figure 20: Percentage of Open Investigations Docket with Pending BWC Requests (January 2024 - May 2025)





Figure 21: Fulfilled BWC Requests (January 2024 - May 2025)

Dispositions

Cases fully investigated by the CCRB generally receive one of five outcomes:

- If the alleged misconduct is found to have occurred, based on the preponderance of the evidence, the allegation is closed as **substantiated**.
- If there is not enough evidence to determine whether or not the alleged misconduct occurred, the allegation is closed as **unable to determine**.*
- If the preponderance of the evidence suggests that the event or alleged act did not occur, the allegation is closed as **unfounded**.
- If the event did occur, but was not improper by a preponderance of evidence, the allegation is closed as within NYPD guidelines.**
- If the CCRB was unable to identify any of the officers accused of misconduct, the case is closed as **officer unidentified**.

Case Abstracts

The following case abstracts are taken from complaints closed this month and serve as examples of what the different CCRB dispositions mean in practice:

1. Substantiated

An individual was at his mother's home when his brother was stopped by the subject officers in front of the home. The individual went outside to the vehicle stop and got into a verbal dispute with the subject officers. The subject officers used physical force against the individual. The incident was captured on BWC. It showed that the individual was verbally hostile to the subject officers and refused their directives to stay on the sidewalk. It showed that the individual was taken to the ground by subject officer 2 after subject officer 1 claimed that the individual spit on him. Both subject officers used their hands to strike the individual multiple times while he was on the ground. The subject officers stated that they struck the individual because he had struck subject officer 2 while he was still standing and that they did so to handcuff the individual. The BWC showed that the individual did not strike the subject officers while he was standing nor while he was on the ground as the subject officers attempted to cuff him. The investigation found that the multiple hand strikes were unreasonable as the individual had not committed a violent crime, had no weapons and was only given orders to give his hands to be handcuffed after he had already been struck. The Board substantiated the Use of Force allegations.

2. Unable to Determine

An individual stated that he was riding a motorcycle when he was stopped by the subject officer's vehicle roadblock. The subject officer stated that he was part of a vehicle task force that was stopping motorcycles and mopeds that appeared to have a vehicle infraction. He stated that he was informed on a private radio channel that the officers were using to stop the individual – the reason given was a possible license plate infraction. The subject officer stated that he proceeded to stop the individual. The investigation could not find the officer that issued the directive to stop the individual, and available BWC footage did not capture a vehicle infraction that would justify the stop of the individual. The Board closed the Abuse of Authority allegation as Unable to Determine.

3. Unfounded

An individual stated that he went outside his home when he heard a fight in the street. He saw his son involved in the fight. His wife had followed him outside and he tried to take his wife back inside their home when he tripped and fell over her slippers. The fall caused him to briefly black out. When he regained consciousness, he saw the subject officer and he noticed people were running down the block. The subject officer pointed to the individual and said, "get him". The individual stated that he was

handcuffed and had his face pressed against a police vehicle, causing stitches in his mouth to burst open. The incident was captured on BWC. When the individual was arrested, only his torso was pressed against the police vehicle, no part of his face was pressed against any police vehicle. The Board closed the Use of Force allegation as Unfounded.

4. Within NYPD Guidelines

An individual stated that she called 911 to specifically request an ambulance for her mentally ill brother who lived in her home. A police officer called her a few minutes later and the individual repeated her request for an ambulance and that she did not want any police officers to respond. EMTs arrived and the individual let them in. She then saw the two subject officers standing outside her apartment. Subject officer 1 insisted that they enter the apartment and the individual refused. Subject officer 1 began pushing on the apartment door and subject officer 2 joined him in pushing on the door while the individual pushed back. The subject officers pushed the door causing an injury to the individual's foot. The incident was captured on BWC and on the 911 call. In the 911 call the individual stated that her brother was acting erratic, had been having a mental breakdown for the past three days, and had been making threats to kill both of them; the individual stated that her brother had the means to carry out his threats. The BWC showed the subject officers arriving with the EMTs at the individual's home. The individual let the EMTs in but refused entry to the subject officers. Subject officer 2 tells the individual that they have go in and sticks his foot in the doorway. Subject officer 1 from behind subject officer 2 pushes on the door. The individual tells the officers that they have injured her foot. Subject officer 1 noted that the individual's foot was by the door. The investigation found that an emergency condition existed that allowed the subject officers to enter the individual's home – the 911 call made by the individual which detailed the dangerous situation that the individual was in and that their use of force to enter the home, pushing on the door was a minimal and reasonable use of force; furthermore the injury to the individual was minimal and was examined by the EMTs on the scene. The Board closed the Abuse of Authority and Use of Force allegations as being Within NYPD Guidelines.

5. Officer Unidentified

An individual stated that while he was on break in a UPS truck, he was parked on a road. There was slow moving traffic on the road and the individual observed a black woman in a silver sedan ahead of a dark colored unmarked police vehicle. The subject officer activated the vehicle's siren and drove past the driver saying, "fucking retard". The individual had a general description of the subject officer and a license plate. The investigation found the vehicle that had the license plate did not match the description given by the individual. The only other vehicle in use that day per its vehicle log was not near the incident location and the officers assigned to the vehicle stated that they made no statements to anyone calling them "fucking retard". Without additional pertinent information, the investigation could not identify the subject officer. The Board closed Discourtesy and Offensive Language allegations as Officer Unidentified.

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^{*} Unable to determine is reported to the Commissioner as Unsubstantiated, meaning that there was insufficient evidence to establish whether or not there was an act of misconduct.

^{**} Within NYPD Guidelines is reported to the Commissioner as Exonerated, meaning there was a preponderance of the evidence that the acts alleged occurred but did not constitute misconduct.

Figure 23: Disposition Counts of Full Investigations (May 2025)





Figure 24: Disposition Counts of Full Investigations (YTD 2025)

Dispositions - Untruthful Statement Allegations

The CCRB investigates untruthful statement allegations under two different allegation categories. Official statements made directly to the CCRB are investigated under the "Untruthful Statement" allegation category. Official statements made in other contexts (e.g. in court) are investigated under the "Abuse of Authority" allegation category.

All the untruthful official statement allegations are mutually exclusive, meaning that the CCRB will not plead more than one untruthful statement allegation against an officer for the same untruthful act. There are four distinct types of untruthful statement allegation as follows: 1) False official statement, 2) Misleading official statement, 3) Inaccurate official statement and 4) Impeding an investigation.

Figure 33: Percentage of Cases Substantiated (January 2024 - May 2025)





Figure 34: Disposition of Substantiated Complaints* (2025)

Figure 35: Substantiation Rates for Full Investigations without Video (Jan 2024 - May 2025) (% substantiated shown)





Figure 36: Substantiation Rates for Full Investigations with Video (Jan 2024 - May 2025) (% substantiated shown)



Board Discipline Recommendations for Substantiated Officers

After a CCRB investigative team has completed its investigation, a panel of Board members determines whether to substantiate the allegation(s) and make a disciplinary recommendation against the officer(s).

- "Charges and Specifications" are the most severe form of discipline. A decision to assign
 Charges commences a process that may result in an administrative trial in the NYPD Trial
 Room. An officer may lose vacation days, be suspended, or be terminated if the officer is
 found guilty.
- "Command Discipline B" and "Command Discipline A" are recommended for misconduct that is moderately serious. An officer can lose up to ten vacation days as a result of Command Discipline B and up to five vacation days as a result of Command Discipline A.
- "Formalized Training" are the least severe discipline, often recommended for officers who misunderstand a policy. This determination results in training at the Police Academy or NYPD Legal Bureau (Formalized Training).
- When the Board has recommended Formalized Training or Command Discipline, the case is sent to the NYPD Commissioner to impose training and/or other penalties. Cases where the Board recommends charges are prosecuted by the CCRB's Administrative Prosecution Unit.

Administrative Prosecution Unit

The CCRB's Administrative Prosecution Unit (APU) prosecutes police misconduct cases when the Board has recommended charges, in the NYPD Trial Room. The APU is also able to offer pleas to officers who admit guilt rather than going to trial. Following a plea agreement or the conclusion of a disciplinary trial, cases are sent to the Police Commissioner for final penalties.
