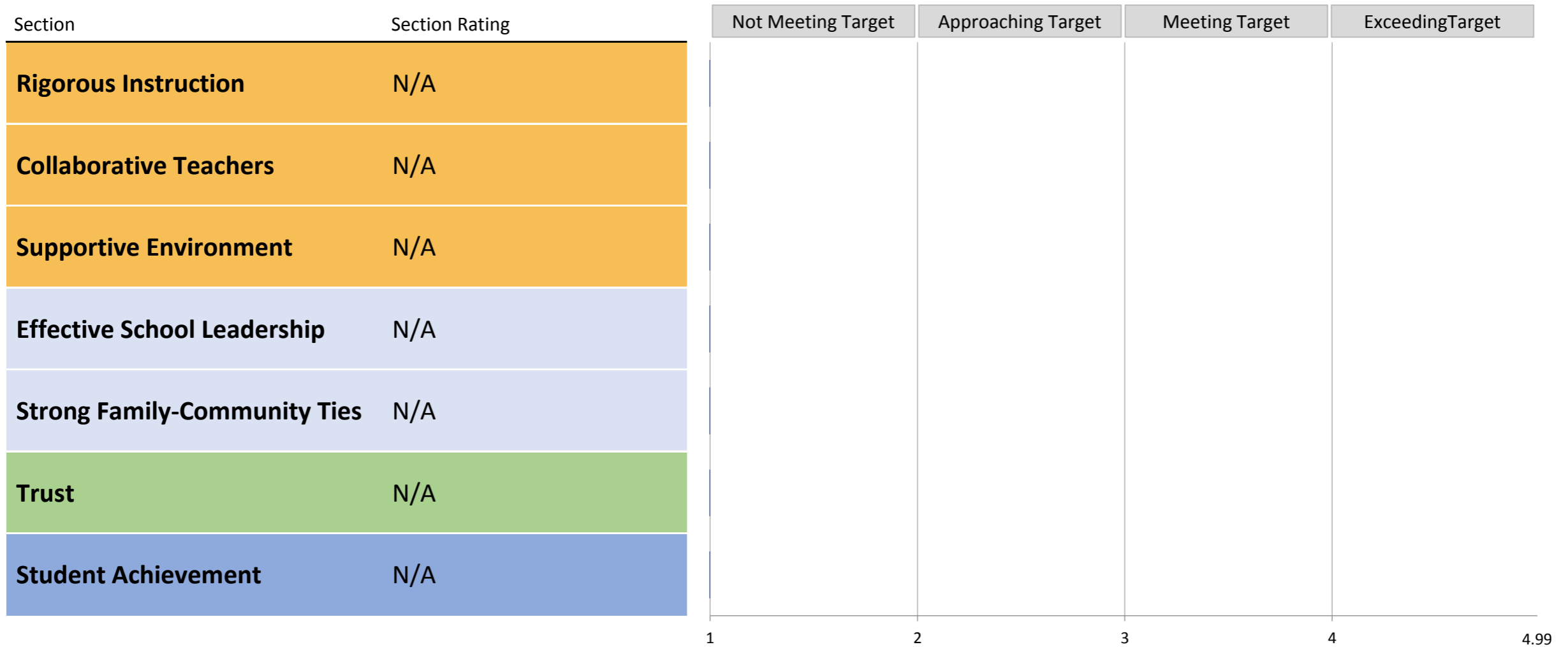

### Framework for Great Schools
