This awareness period was created by Senator Bob Dole and Congressman Bill Richardson with support from Men's Health Network. It was passed by the U.S. Congress and signed into law by President Clinton in 1994 as Men's Health Week (the week ending on the U.S. Father's Day). Men's Health Week was expanded to include the whole month of June in the late 1990s.





older adults for disaster. The campaign will specifically target older adults from communities that are disproportionately impacted by the all-hazard events, which continue to threaten the nation.

According to the [American Red Cross](#), there are several factors that make older adults more vulnerable after disasters, including, but not limited to:

- a greater likelihood to suffer from chronic conditions and the need for associated medications.
- a greater reliance on assistive devices such as walkers or glasses, as well as support from caregivers and others; and
- an increased likelihood of social isolation.



This Monday, June 19th is Juneteenth, also known as Freedom Day, Emancipation Day, Jubilee Day, and Liberation Day; a holiday that celebrates the end of slavery in the United States.

Personal celebrations for Juneteenth may include gatherings among friends, barbecues and cookouts, and/or firework displays. Others may use the day to shop at black-owned businesses or share history with family and friends. Colors are also significant during this holiday. Some will dress in red, white, and blue, the colors of the Juneteenth flag, while others will dress in red, green, and black, the colors of the Pan-African flag.


