An Update on Occupancy Submissions



The Department of Buildings is working to address the high volume of occupancy submissions that have been received since [the expansion of DOB NOW](#) on March 1, 2021.

Schedule of Occupancy and *Certificate of Occupancy* requests that were submitted to the Department in [DOB NOW: Build](#) by **March 24, 2021** will receive a first-time review on or before **March 31, 2021**.

In addition, a 90-day extension has been granted for *Temporary Certificates of Occupancy* (TCO) if steps have been taken to renew the TCO in DOB NOW before the expiration date of the TCO. Those who have taken steps to renew a TCO in [DOB NOW: Build](#) prior to the TCO's expiration date will be receiving an email from a DOB Borough Commissioner granting the 90-day extension, subject to all conditions for which the TCO was granted.
