EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63

January 14, 1982

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section, 1. Prior Order Amended. Paragraph (a) of Section 5 of Executive Order Number 10 (1978), as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"§ 5. Committee Membership. (a) The Committee shall consist of twenty-seven members, each residing or having a principal place of business in the City of New York, appointed by the Mayor. The Mayor shall choose thirteen members including the chairman, and the Presiding Justices of the Appellate Division for the First and Second Judicial Departments shall each choose six members. The members chosen by the Mayor and Presiding Justices shall serve for a term of one year. In each year two deans of law schools within the City of New York shall each choose one member who shall serve for a term of one year, with those deans performing this function rotating annually among such deans. Vacancies in the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as initial appointments. A member of the Committee may be removed by the Mayor for cause."

§ 2. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately.
