EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86 JUNE 7, 1977

AMENDMENT OF EXECUTICE ORDER NO. 28 DATED MARCH 31, 1975

Whereas, It is necessary and desirable to amend Executive Order No. 28, dated March 31, 1975, which established a Commission on the Status of Women.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Section 1 of the Executive Order No. 28 dated March 31, 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. There is hereby established under the direction of the Office of the Mayor a Commission on the Status of Women, which shall consist of thirty-eight members appointed by the Mayor, including a Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson who shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor, the Chairperson of the New York City Commission on Human Rights who shall serve ex officio and thirty-five members who shall serve as follows: twelve members shall be appointed for terms expiring on December 31, 1977; twelve shall be appointed for terms expiring on December 31, 1978; and eleven shall be appointed for terms expiring on December 31, 1979. Thereafter, all members other than the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and ex officio member shall be appointed for terms of three years. Should a vacancy occur prior to the expiration of the term of any member, such vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term."

§ 2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
