

## FDNY Graduates 304 Probationary Firefighters



On April 18, FDNY Fire Commissioner Daniel A. Nigro presided over the graduation of 304 Probationary Firefighters at Christian Cultural Center in Brooklyn. During the ceremony, Commissioner Nigro highlighted the diversity of this latest class.

"Our Department is continuing to better represent the diverse city we serve, as 37% of our Probies are people of color - and with six new women in this outstanding class, I can proudly say that more women serve as New York City Firefighters today than at any point in our history," he said.

Of the 304 graduating Probationary Firefighters, 17.4% identify as Hispanic, 16.1% as African-American, and 2.6% as Asian-American/Pacific Islander. There were also six women in the class, bringing the total number of female Firefighters to 64 – the highest total in FDNY history. This class also had 38 veterans, which includes members from all five branches of the U.S. Armed Forces. Read more on our website.
