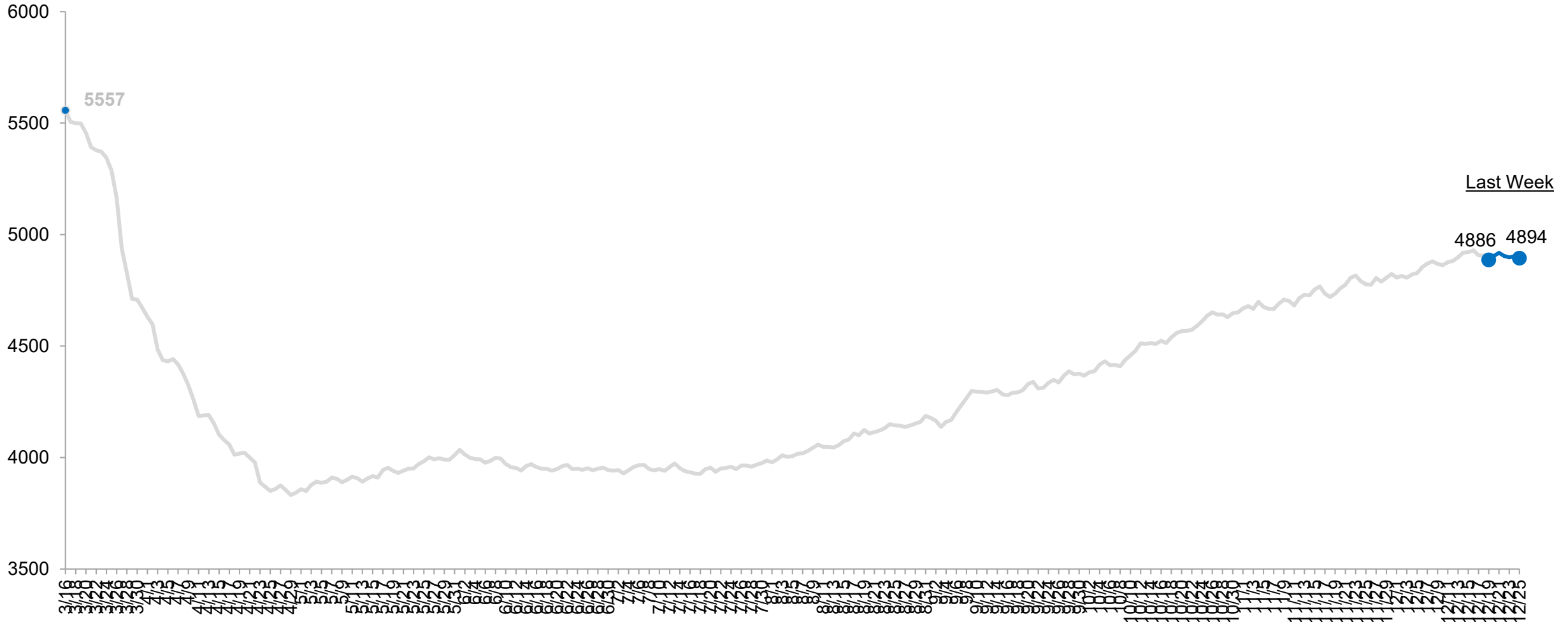

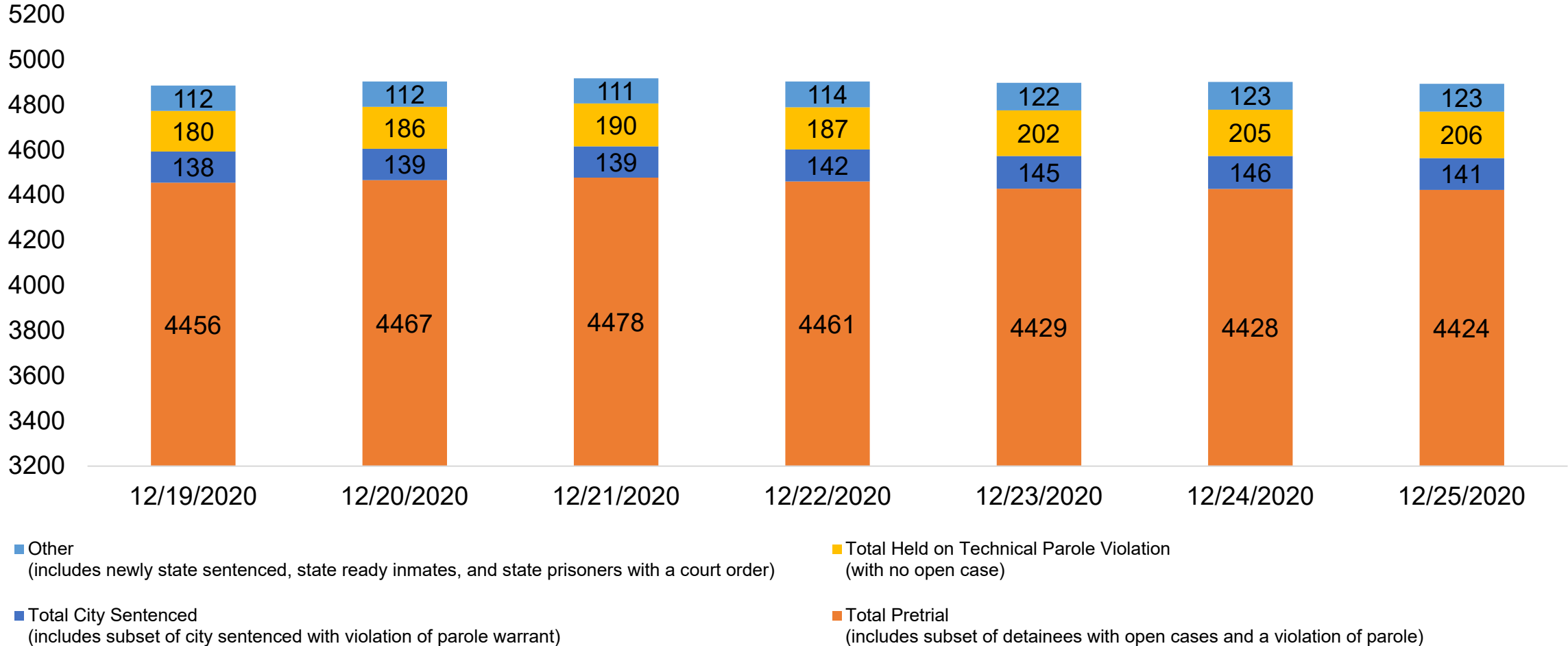
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – December 25, 2020

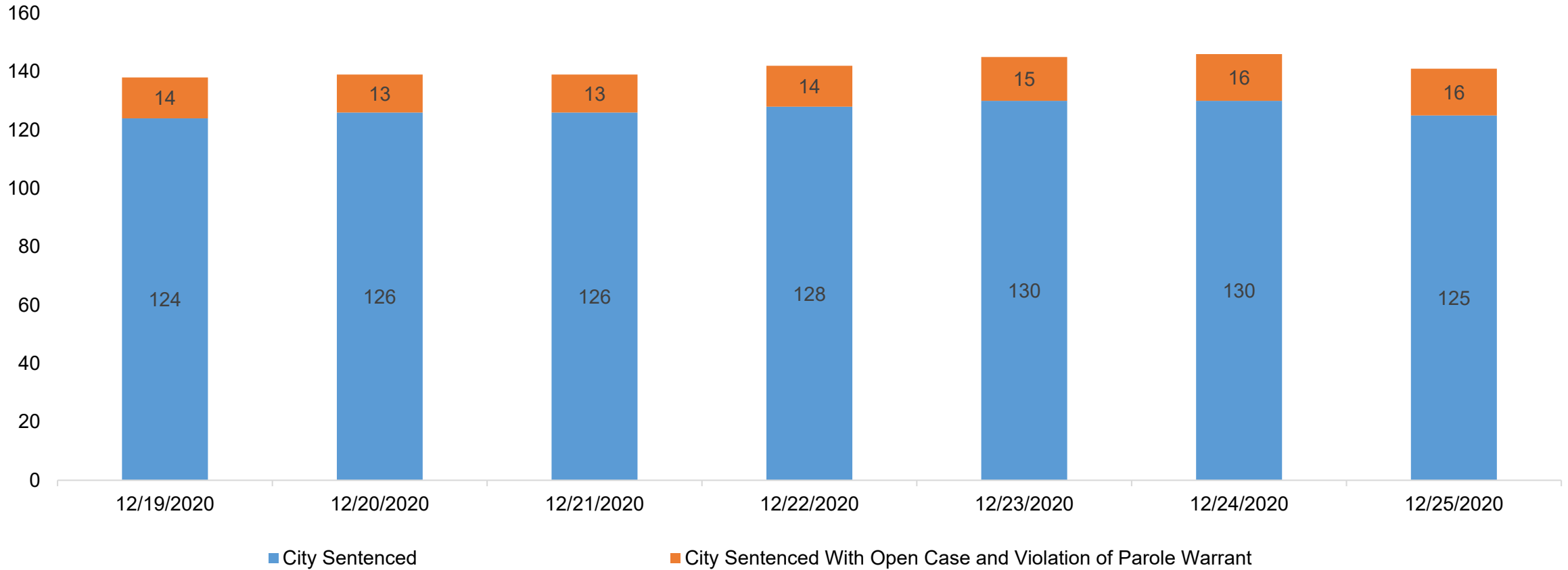

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 12/19/2020-12/25/2020



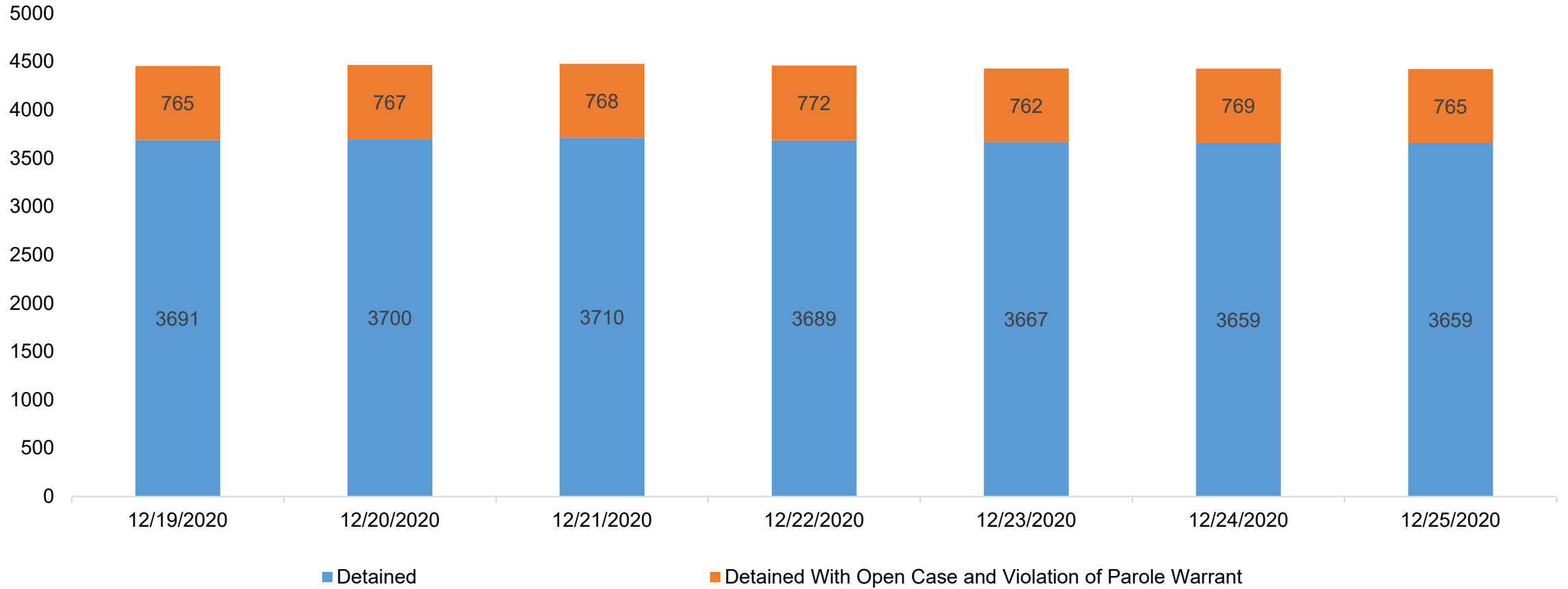

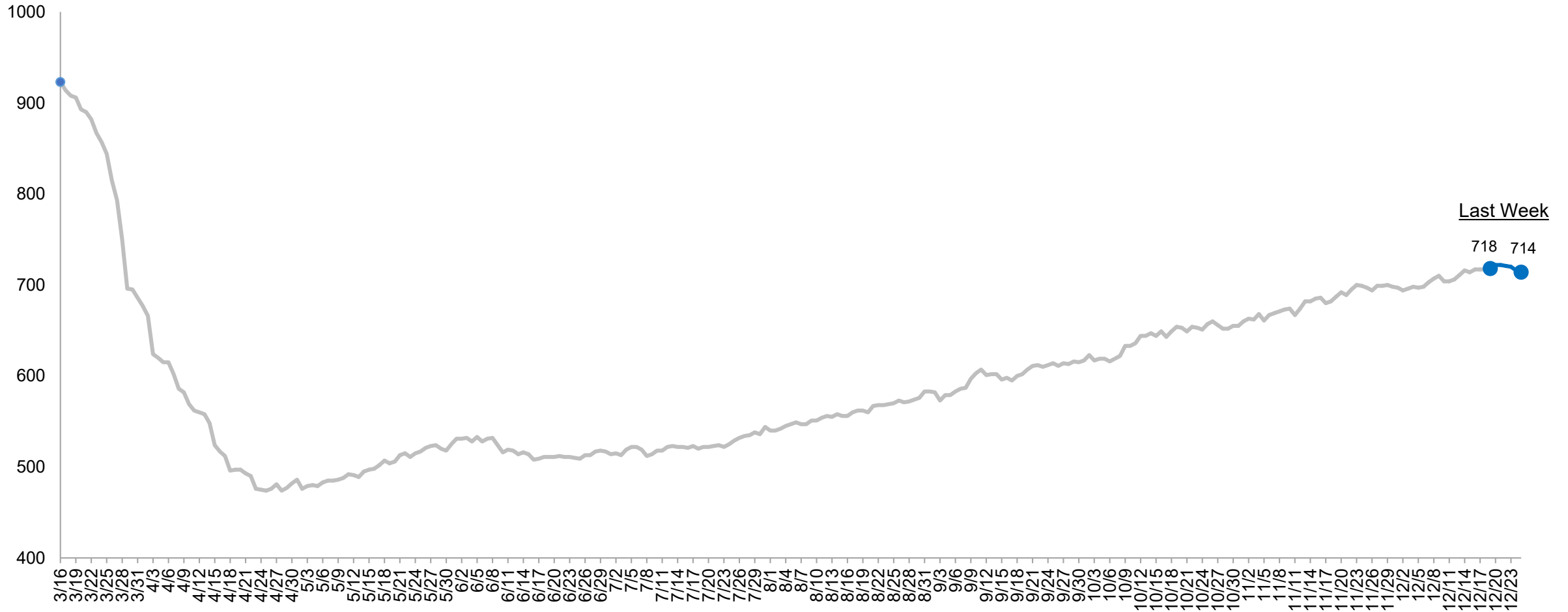

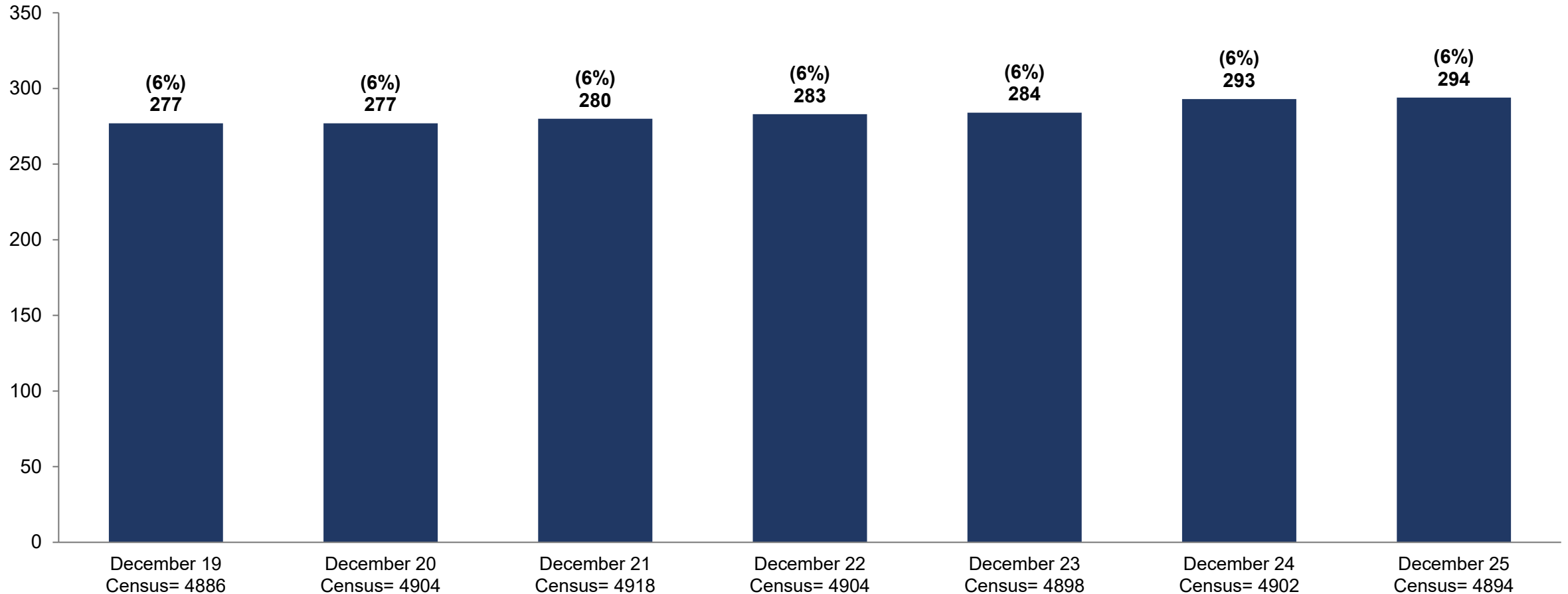

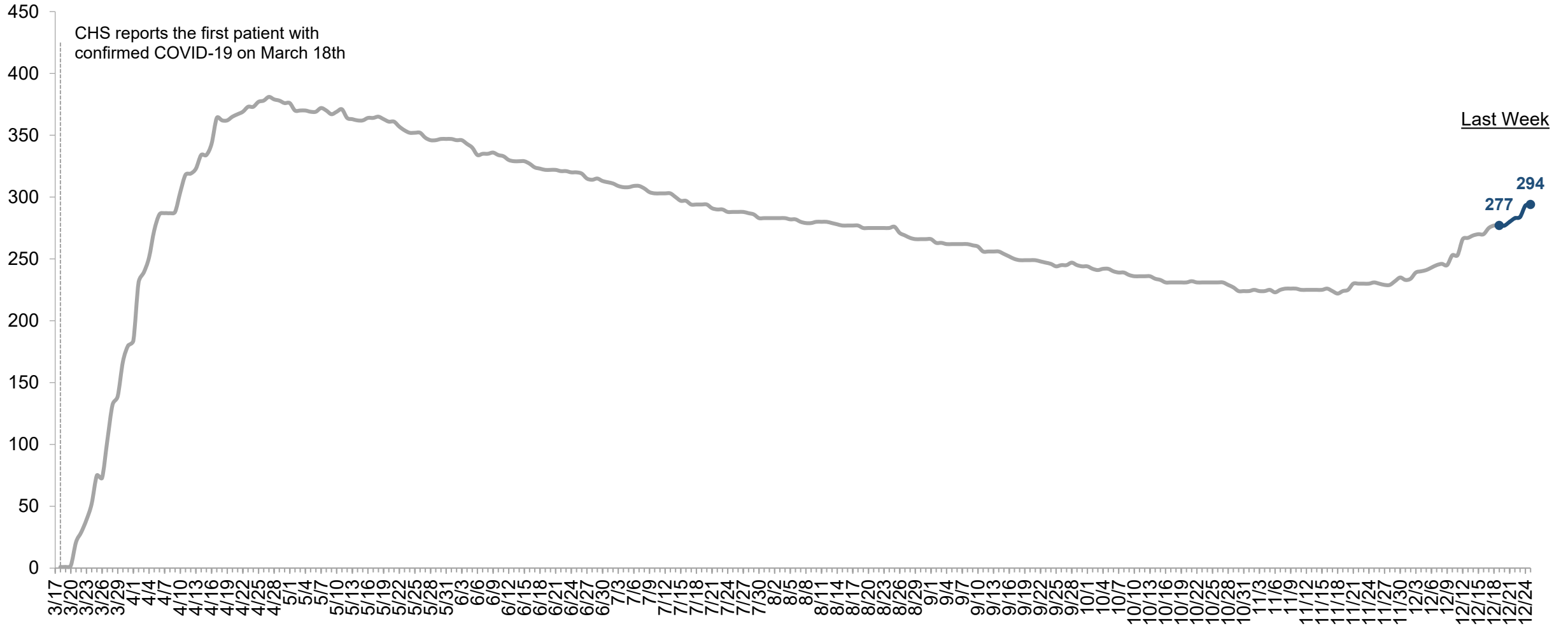
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

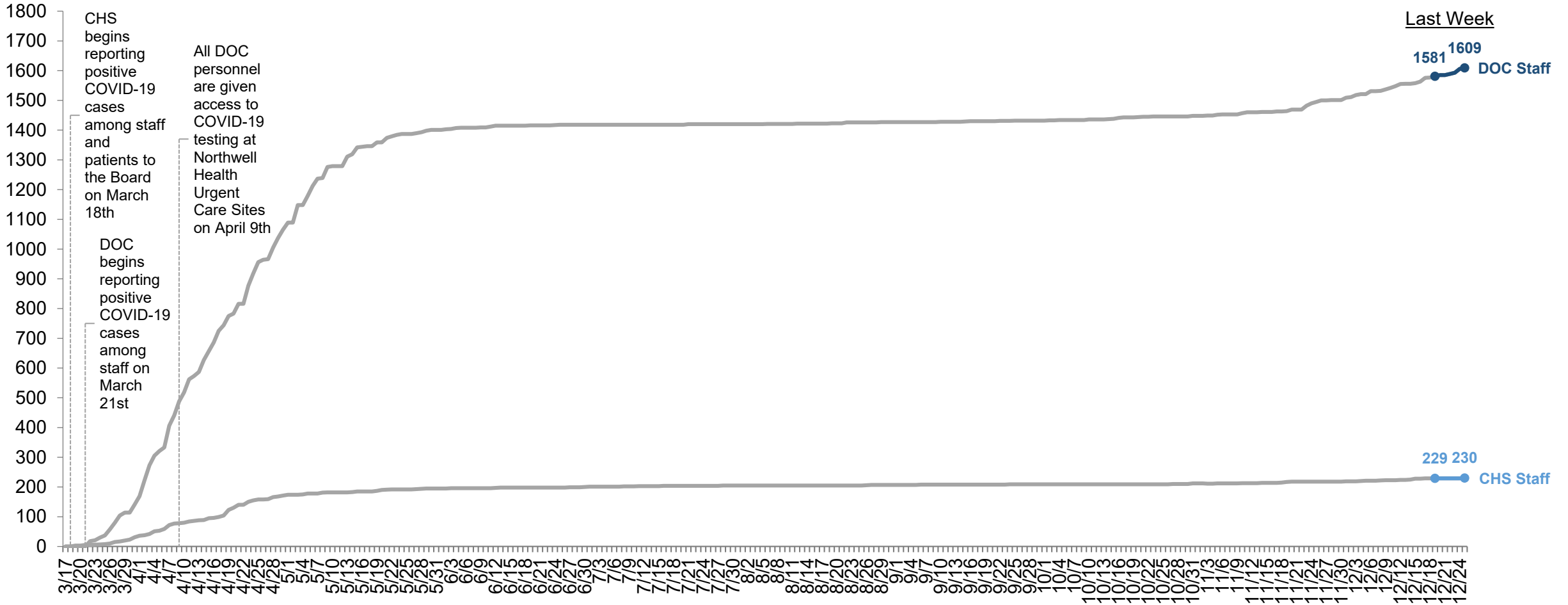
**Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

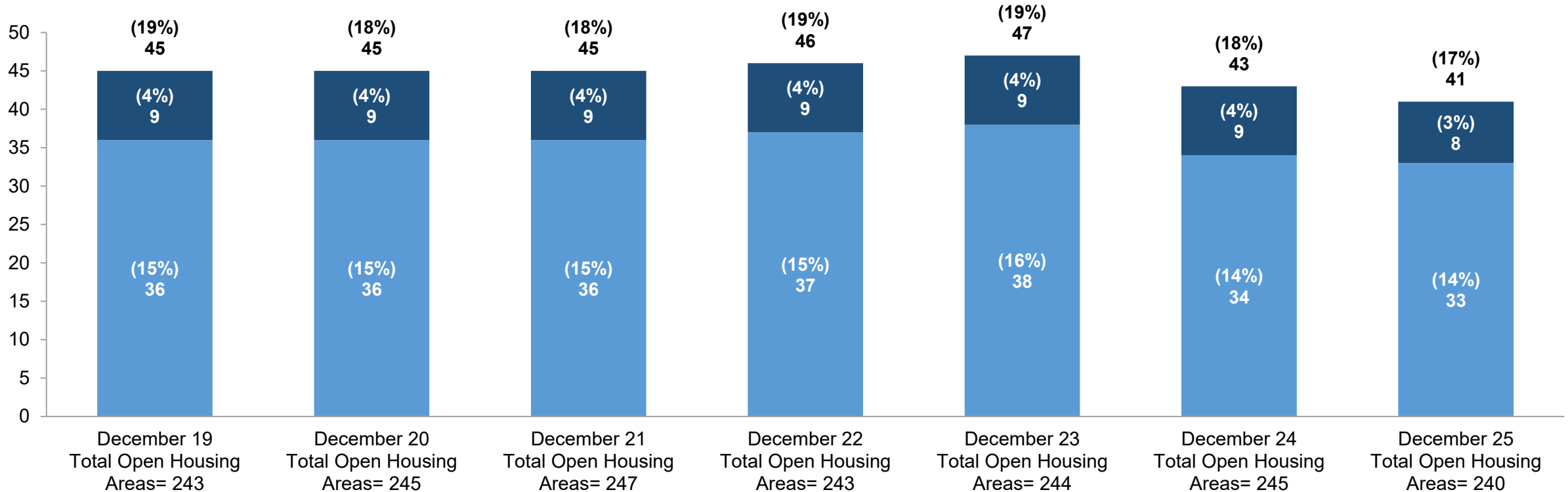

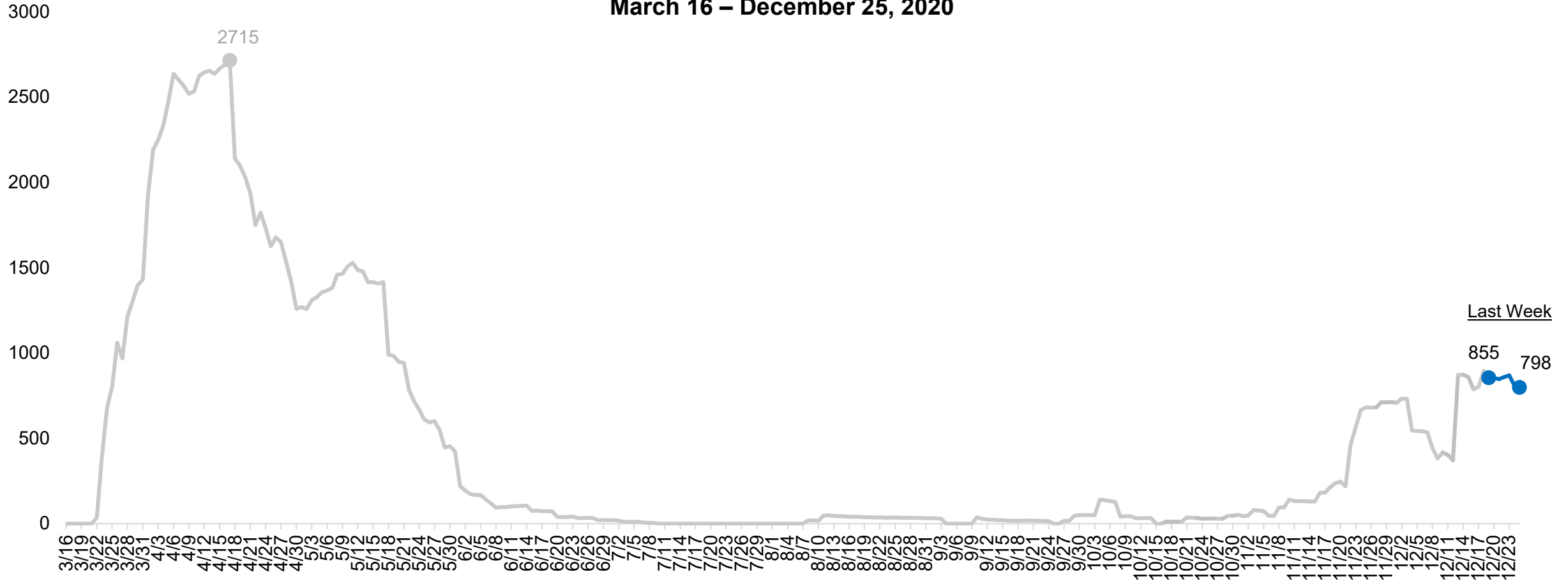

March 16 – December 25, 2020**

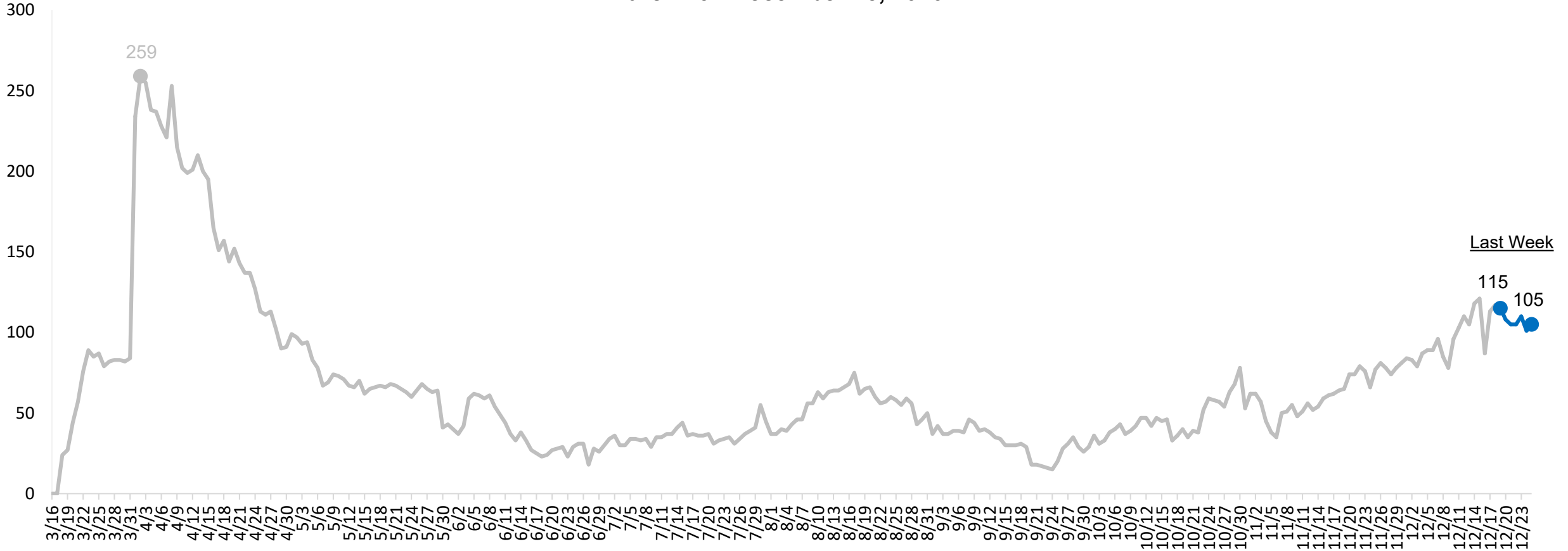

Total People in Housing Areas Used for Confirmed and Symptomatic Patients, March 16 - December 25, 2020

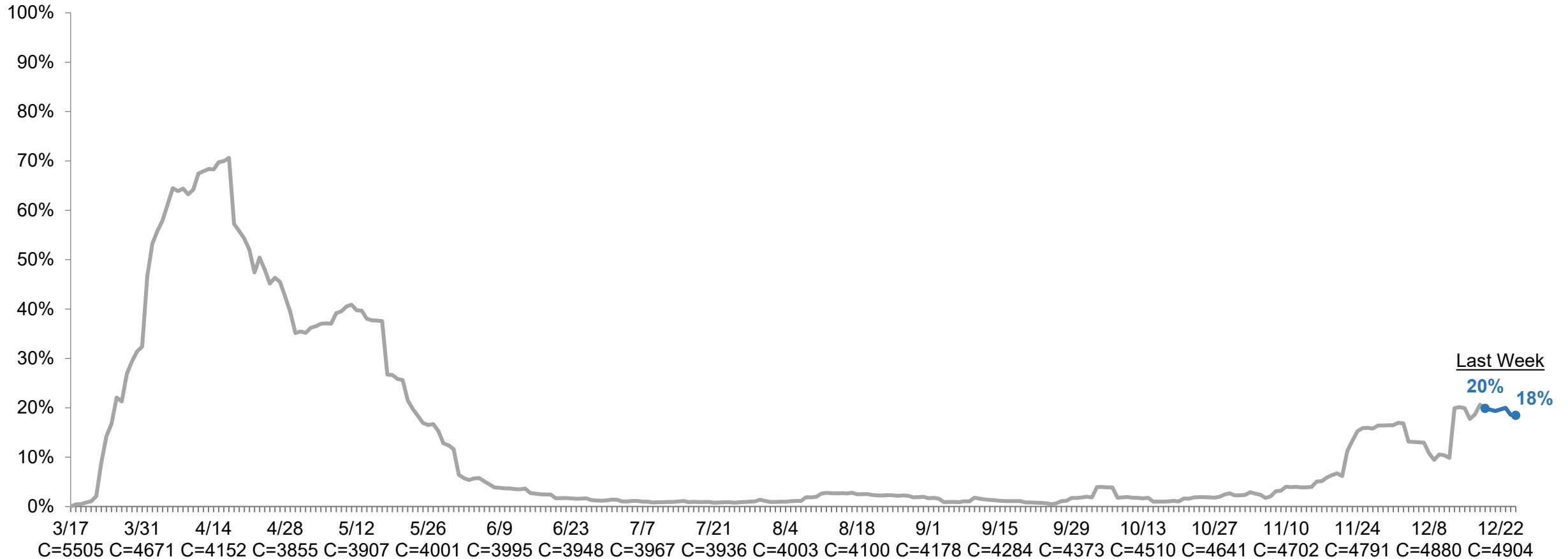

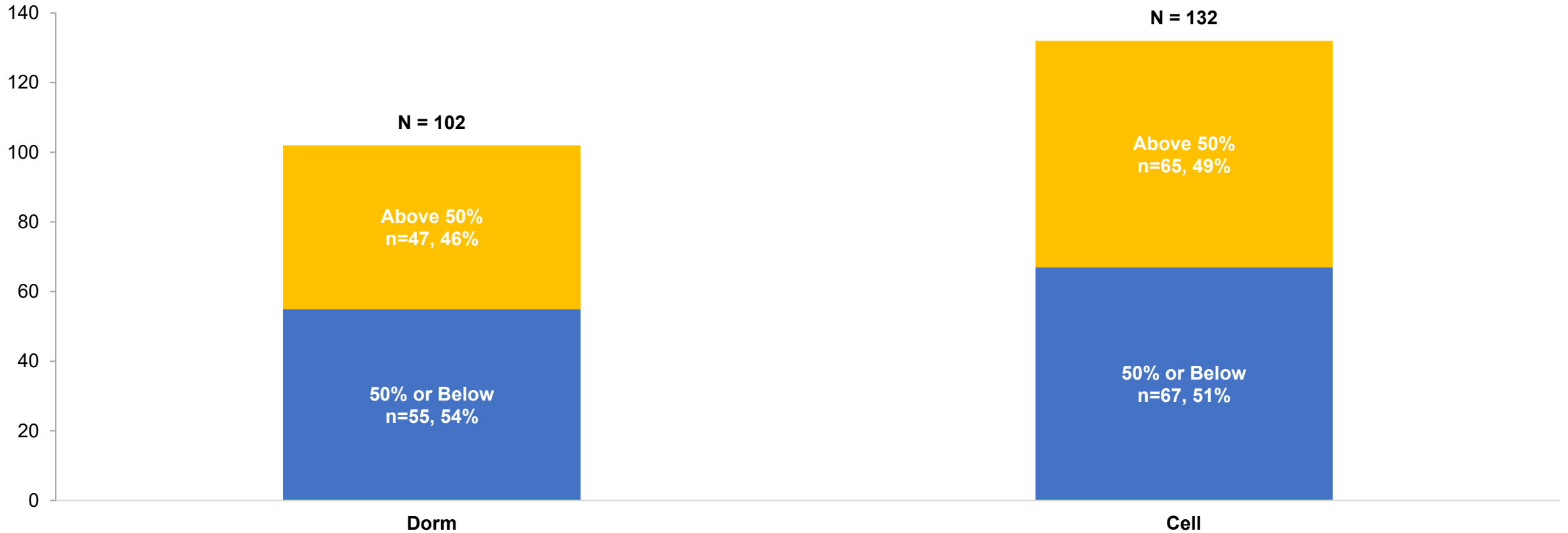

December 24, 2020



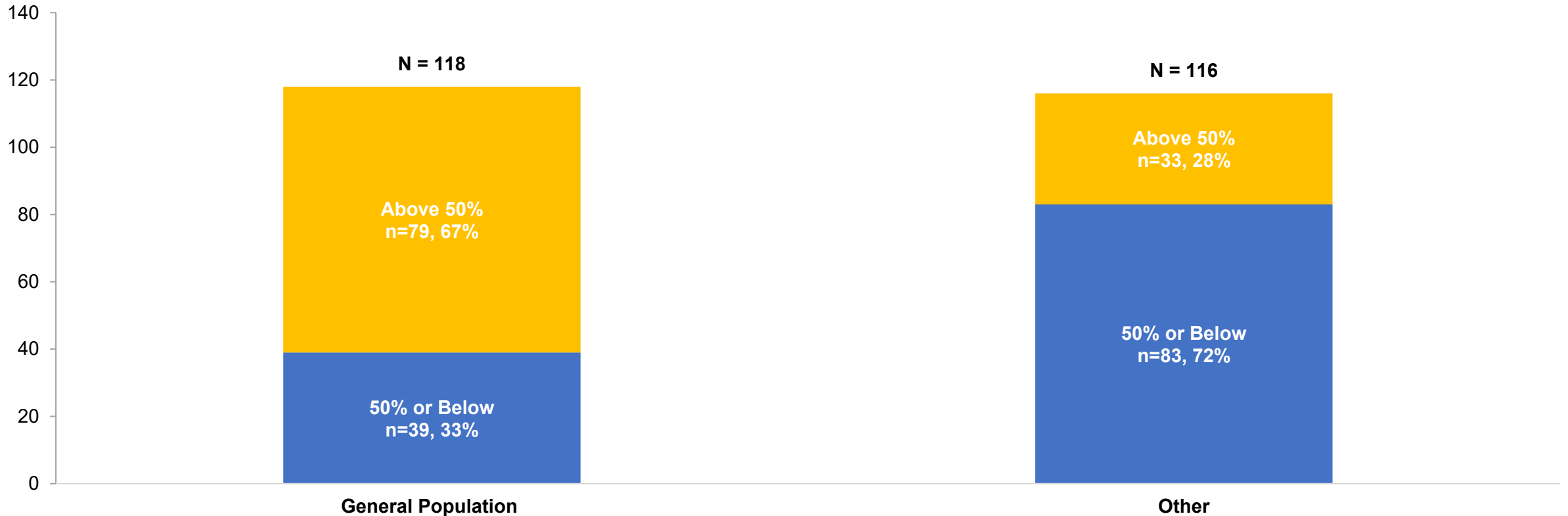

December 24, 2020



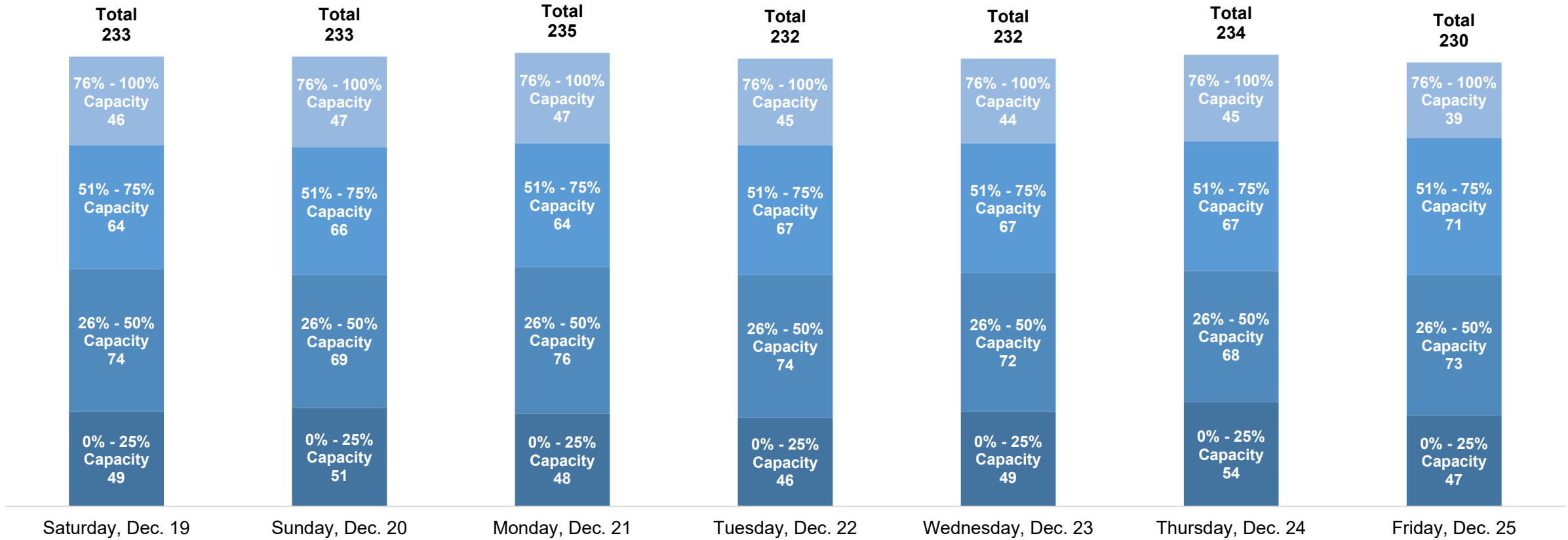
