Annual Disclosure: Going the Distance

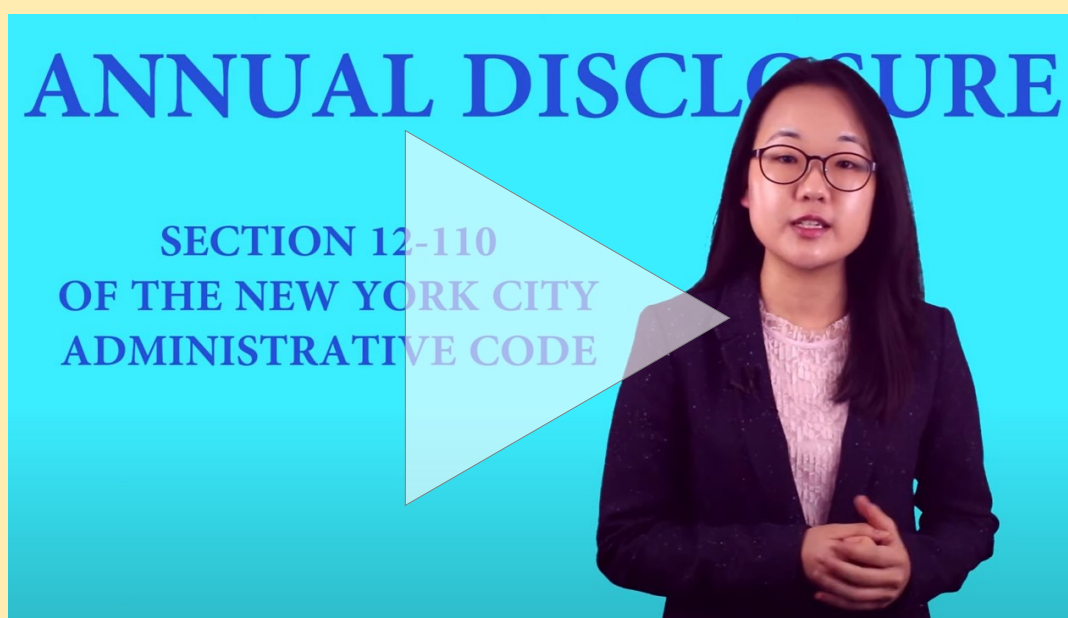

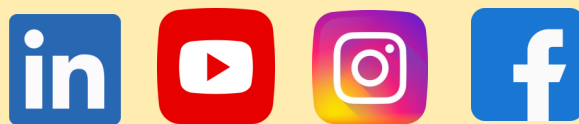
The More You Know: Annual Disclosure
