Vision Zero Fall 2024 Back to School Safety Notice

This Thursday, September 5, NYC public schools are back in session. Please share these important reminders with trade waste drivers and helpers as safety must be the #1 priority during operations:

- Drivers should be familiar with school zones.
- Always stop for school bus lights and obey crossing guards.
- Be careful around parked vehicles. Children who are waiting to cross may be especially difficult to see when standing behind cars.
- Slow down! NYC's speed limit is 25 MPH. A pedestrian struck at 30 MPH is **twice as likely to be killed** than if struck at 25 MPH. A safe turning speed is 5 MPH.
- Drive **ONLY** on the correct side of the road, **even if that means making additional turns** to complete a trade waste stop.
- Stay clear of cross walks, bike lanes, and sidewalks.
- Before making a turn, scan the intersection ahead for potential hazards and then turn slowly.
- Exercise extreme caution during loading and unloading of waste containers. This should never occur while the vehicle is moving or while in close proximity to pedestrians and cyclists.
