Local Law 97: Building Emissions Adjustments Applications



Starting April 12, 2021, DOB will begin accepting applications for adjustments to a building a sannual emissions limits for the **2024-2029** calendar years and for not-for-profit hospitals and healthcare facilities. Applications for adjustments must be submitted in <u>DOB</u> <u>NOW: Safety</u>. Please read our <u>Service Notice</u> for full details.

Excessive Emissions Due to a Special Circumstance

The deadline for applications for adjustments to annual building emissions limits for calendar years 2024-2029 for buildings with excessive emissions <u>due to a special circumstance</u> is **June 30, 2021**. The filing fee for these applications is **\$2,450**.

Not-for-profit Hospitals and Healthcare Facilities

Applications for adjustments to annual building emissions limits for notfor-profit hospitals and healthcare facilities must be submitted **no later than July 21, 2021**. The filing fee for these applications is **\$335**.
