



Section 2. Buildings Penalty Schedule II, found in Section 3-103 of Subchapter G of Chapter 3 of Title 48 of the Rules of the City of New York, is amended by adding two new entries immediately following the entry in that Penalty Schedule for BC 3303.7.3, "Failure to Post No Smoking signs at construction/demolition sites per Fire Code" to read as follows:



Statement of Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rule

The Environmental Control Board (ECB) proposes to add four new charges to ECB's Buildings Penalty Schedule II, found in Section 3-103 of Subchapter G of Chapter 3 of Title 48 of the Rules of the City of New York. These charges are being added due to the enactment of Local Laws 63 and 64 of 2009 both of which became effective on February 4, 2010.

Local Law 63 amends BC 1704.21 and 1704.22 requiring successful hydrostatic pressure testing of new and altered sprinkler and standpipe systems in buildings. Hydrostatic pressure tests will ensure the integrity of these systems during construction or demolition operations.

Local Law 63 also provides that, for new buildings under construction, required standpipes must undergo an initial hydrostatic pressure test of the entire system when the building reaches a height of 75 feet. Additional successful hydrostatic pressure tests of the entire system shall be performed at 175 feet and at every 100 feet in height thereafter. Where there is an enlargement that triggers a new standpipe system, or there is an addition to an existing standpipe system, hydrostatic pressure tests of the entire system shall be performed for every 75 feet of additional height added to the system. In addition, where stories are removed from a building served by an existing standpipe system, hydrostatic pressure tests of the entire system shall be performed prior to the commencement of work.

Local Law 64 amends BC 3303.8 by adding a new section, BC 3303.8.1 requiring air pressurized alarm systems for dry standpipe systems during construction and demolition operations. An air pressurized alarm system will quickly alert workers, authorities and emergency responders whenever there is any compromise of the standpipe system. The law provides that in all vacant buildings and structures undergoing demolition, all existing standpipes are to be maintained in a state of readiness and must be provided with an air pressurized alarm system. For new buildings and structures, all required permanent and temporary standpipes must remain in a state of readiness once work reaches a height of 75 feet and must contain an air pressurized alarm system. In addition, whenever a planned event will cause a standpipe system and standpipe air pressurized alarm system to be temporarily deactivated, such actions must be strictly documented by the site safety manager or coordinator, and comply with the notification requirement of section 901.7.7 of the Fire Code.

Because of the serious nature of these operations involving operable sprinkler and standpipe systems, the Department of Buildings has designated these charges to be immediately hazardous (class 1) violations.

ECB therefore proposes to add four new charges to ECB's Buildings Penalty Schedule II to allow for adequate and effective enforcement of these new laws. The Department of Buildings will also amend section 102-01 of subchapter B of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York, which includes the classifications of particular DOB violations, to reflect these changes.

Note - The Standard Default and Aggravated II penalties are both 5 times the Standard penalty; the Aggravated I penalty is 2 1/2 times the Standard penalty; the Aggravated I default penalty is 10 times the Standard penalty; and the Aggravated II Default penalty is the statutory maximum.

Amendments to Rules Relating to the Filing of Income and Expense Statements

Section 1. Paragraph (1) of subdivision (b) of section 33-02 of 19 RCNY Chapter 33 (Rules Relating to the Filing of Income and Expense Statements) is amended to read as follows: (1) Income and expense statements shall be submitted electronically in the format prepared by the Department of Finance and located on the Department of Finance Internet website and in accordance with the instructions for submission of the income and expense statement found on the website. [The only acceptable substitute for required lease information is a computerized rent roll containing the same information as is required in the form.]

§2. A new paragraph (5) is added to subdivision (c) of section 33-02 of such rules to read as follows:

(5) In addition to the income and expense statement, owners of income-producing property as to which the final actual assessed value for the tax year during which the statement is filed is \$750,000 or greater must file an addendum thereto, in a format determined by the Commissioner of Finance, containing rent roll information for the month of April of the year during which the income and expense statement is required to be filed. The addendum required by this paragraph shall be considered to be a part of the income and expense statement and any filing requirement contained in these rules for the income and expense statement shall also be applicable to the addendum.

 (\underline{v}) failure to file a substantially complete <u>and accurate</u> income and expense statement which shall include but shall not be limited to:

(A) failure to provide data for the appropriate accounting period; and

 $(B)\ failure\ to\ provide\ a\ complete\ \underline{and}\ accurate\ and\ itemized$ list of income and expense data; or

[(v)] (vi) in the event that the electronic filing requirement is waived by the Commissioner under § 33-02(b)(2) of these rules, failure to use the forms prepared by the Department of Finance, or failure to submit an income and expense statement containing the original signature of the owner(s) (the signature of an agent is not acceptable unless a power of attorney is attached to the statement).

BASIS AND PURPOSE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

Section 11-208.1 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York requires that owners of income producing real property in New York City file income and expense statements relating to the property each year no later than September 1. The information provided on the statements is used by the Department of Finance in assessing real property in the City. Prior to amending the Rules Relating to the Filing of Income and Expense Statements in 2005 in an attempt to simplify filing requirements, the Department of Finance had required owners of nonresidential real property with an assessed valuation of \$1 million or greater to include with the income and expense statement an addendum with detailed rent roll information. The Department has since determined that this information would be helpful in determining accurate assessments, and these amendments to rules restore the addendum requirement as modified to require the addendum for any property that has an assessed valuation of \$750,000 or greater.

The rule amendment also clarifies the term failure to file an income and expense statement. As amended, the term failure to file an income and expense statement includes failure to file a substantially complete and accurate income expense statement and failure to provide a complete and accurate and itemized list of income and expense data.

(iii) failure to complete forms in a legible manner;

(iv) failure to submit an addendum, when required under <u>§33-02(c)(5) of these rules;</u>

HOW TO READ CR PROCUREMENT NOTICES
Procurement Notices in the CR are arranged by

alphabetically listed Agencies, and within Agency, by Division if any. The notices for each Agency (or Division) are further divided into three subsections: Solicitations, Awards; and Lists & Miscellaneous notices. Each of these subsections separately lists notices pertaining to Goods, Services, or Construction.

Notices of Public Hearings on Contract Awards appear at the end of the Procurement Section. At the end of each Agency (or Division) listing is a paragraph giving the specific address to contact to secure, examine and/or to submit bid or proposal documents, forms, plans, specifications, and other information, as well as where bids will be publicly opened and read. This address should be used for the purpose specified UNLESS a different one is given in the individual notice. In that event, the directions in the individual notice should be followed. The following is a SAMPLE notice and an explanation of the notice format used by the CR.

EXPLANATION

READER'S GUIDE

The City Record (CR) is, published each business day and includes notices of proposed New York City procurement actions, contract awards, and other procurement-related information. Solicitation notices for most procurements valued at or above \$100,000 for information technology and for construction and construction related services, above \$50,000 for other services, and above \$25,000 for other goods are published for at least one day. Other types of procurements, such as sole source, require notice in the City Record for five consecutive days. Unless otherwise specified, the agencies and offices listed are open for business Mondays thru Fridays from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. except legal holidays.

NOTICE TO ALL NEW YORK CITY CONTRACTORS

The New York State Constitution ensures that all laborers. workers or mechanics employed by a contractor or subcontractor doing public work are to be paid the same wage rate that prevails in the trade where the public work is being done. Additionally, New York State Labor Law §§ 220 and 230 provide that a contractor or subcontractor doing public work in construction or building service must pay its employees no less than the prevailing wage. Section 6-109 (the Living Wage Law) of the New York City Administrative Code also provides for a "living wage", as well as prevailing wage, to be paid to workers employed by City contractors in certain occupations. The Comptroller of the City of New York is mandated to enforce prevailing wage. Contact the NYC Comptrollers Office at www.comptroller.nyc.gov, click on Labor Law Schedules to view rates.

New York City's "Burma Law" (Local Law No. 33 of 1997) No Longer to be Enforced. In light of the United States Supreme Court's decision in Crosby v. National Foreign Trade Council, 530 U.S. 363 (2000), the City has determined that New York City's Local Law No. 33 of 1997 (codified in Administrative Code Section 6-115 and Charter Section 1524), which restricts City business with banks and companies doing business in Burma, is unconstitutional. This is to advise, therefore, that the language relating to Burma contained in existing New York City contracts may not be enforced.

CONSTRUCTION/CONSTRUCTION SERVICES OR CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES

The City of New York is committed to achieving excellence in the design and construction of its capital program, and building on the tradition of innovation in architecture and engineering that has contributed to the City's prestige as a global destination.

VENDOR ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

New York City procures approximately \$7 billion worth of goods, services, construction and construction-related services every year. The NYC Procurement Policy Board Rules require that agencies primarily solicit from established mailing lists called bidder/proposer lists. To register for these lists--free of charge-, prospective suppliers should fill out and submit the NYC-FMS Vendor Enrollment application.

Even if you already do business with NYC agencies, be sure to fill out an application. We are switching over to citywide, centralized Bidders Lists instead of the agency-specific lists previously used to issue notices about upcoming contract opportunities. To continue receiving notices of New York City contract opportunities, you must fill out and submit a NYC-FMS Vendor Enrollment application.

SELLING TO GOVERNMENT TRAINING WORKSHOP New and experienced vendors are encouraged to register for

PRE-QUALIFIED LIST

New York City procurement policy permits agencies to develop and solicit from pre-qualified lists of vendors, under prescribed circumstance. When it is decided by an agency to develop a pre-qualified list, criteria for pre-qualification must be clearly explained in the solicitation and notice of the opportunity to pre-qualify for that solicitation must be published in at least five issues of the CR.

Information and qualification questionnaires for inclusion on such list may be obtained directly from the Agency Chief Contracting Officer at each agency, (see Vendor Information Manual). A completed qualification Questionnaire may be submitted to the Chief Contracting Officer at any time, unless otherwise indicated and action (approval or denial) shall be taken by the agency within 90 days from the date of submission. Any denial or revocation of pre-qualified status can be appealed to the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings, (OATH), Section 3-11 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules describes the criteria for the general use of prequalified lists.

KEY TO METHODS OF SOURCE SELECTION

The Procurement Policy Board (PPB) of the City of New York has by rule defined the appropriate methods of source selection for City procurement and reasons justifying their use. The CR procurement notices of many agencies include an abbreviated reference to the source selection method utilized. The following is a list of those methods and the abbreviations used:
