



Disciplinary Cases

- A filing representative s registration was suspended for one month for unprofessional conduct.
- A filing representative was cited for negligence and incompetence due to scheduling numerous appointments with plan examiners, but being unprepared and lacking necessary documents to resolve objections at each meeting. A Class-1 violation was imposed and he was fined \$1,600. The Department denied the filing representative their registration renewal request.
- A registered filing representative was cited for negligence and incompetence based on having missed a high number of appointments with plan examiners.
- A master plumber and fire suppression contractor was disciplined for failure to have workers on the company payroll, for failure to personally sign and seal applications, and for making false and misleading statements to investigators. He was fined \$10,000 for the misconduct.
