


## I. Population Change: Total Population in DOC Custody

### Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 - July 24, 2020





## I. Population Change: DOC Population by Custody Status












Number of Patients Currently Under Observation by CHS


Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19





March 16th - July 24th, 2020**




**Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 - July 24th, 2020**
