Does your community organization have an idea for a community preparedness project for this year?

NYCEM Community Preparedness is partnering with Citizens Committee for NYC (aka CitizensNYC) to present an info session on their grant program. CitizensNYC awards micro-grants to community groups and small businesses focused on improving neighborhood life and strengthening local leadership. Two funding opportunities are currently available: The All In Neighborhood Grant (AING) Program awards up to \$5,000 for community-building projects, and the Neighborhood Business Grant Program distributes up to \$10,000 for payroll and operations.

CitizensNYC gives priority to innovative projects that address critical needs in underserved communities. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis; eligible stakeholders are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
