

Passover also called Pesach (sundown of April 22 – sundown of April 30) is a Jewish holiday that celebrates the Israelites being freed from slavery in Egypt. It is observed for seven or eight days and during the first and sometimes the second night, Passover is celebrated with a home ritual known as the Passover seder.

The seder, or order in Hebrew is celebrated around a dinner table. It includes the retelling of the Passover story - the story of Exodus from the Torah (or the Old Testament) — blessings over food and wine, explanations of Passover symbols, discussions of freedom and social justice, and plenty of singing and eating. All of these rituals are performed in an order prescribed by a Passover-specific book known as a Haggadah (which means "telling" in Hebrew).

During Passover, Jews may not own or consume chametz, anything containing grain that has risen. Instead Jews eat Matzah, a cracker-like food, which reminds them of their ancestors having no time to allow their bread to rise as they were leaving Egypt.



- 4. Starting compressions 100-120 times per minute until further help arrives.



THINGS TO KNOW



How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:

- Event organizer submits an official request using the <u>NYC CERT External Request Form</u>.
- NYC CERT Leadership should not submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this <u>Event</u> Request form

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the NYC CERT Event Calendar

with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


